ISAIAH 50:1-4

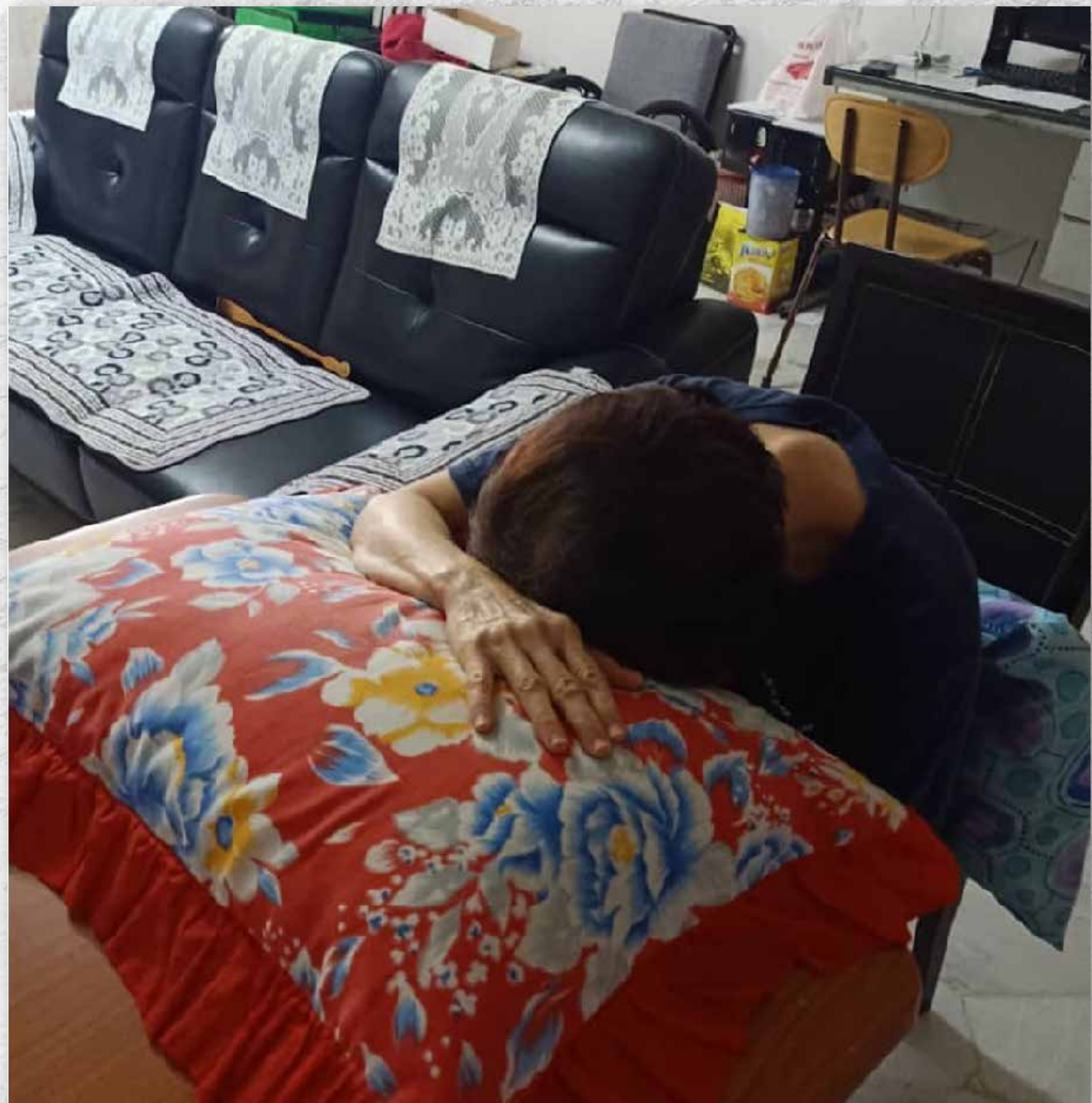
Thus says the Lord:
