The OBEDIENT SACRIFICE

CONTEXT:

- **Prophet Isaiah**
- **Book of Isaiah**
- **Servant Songs**
– **Isaiah 42, 49, 50, 52/53**
- **Isaiah 52/53**

Jesus' OBEDIENCE
is in a league of its own

PHILIPPIANS 2

⁶ Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; ⁷ rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.

⁸ And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming **obedient to death - even death on a cross!**

Jesus' obedience is illustrated here:

ISAIAH 52

¹³ See, my servant will act wisely;
he will be raised and lifted up
and highly exalted.

¹⁴ Just as there were many who
were appalled at him -
his appearance was so
disfigured beyond that of any
human being
and his form marred beyond
human likeness -

ISAIAH 52

¹⁵ so he will sprinkle many nations,

and kings will shut their mouths because of him.

For what they were not told, they will see,

and what they have not heard, they will understand.

ANTICIPATION of DEATH

ISAIAH 53

Who has believed our message
and to whom has the arm of the
Lord been revealed?

² He grew up before him like a
tender shoot,

and like a root out of dry
ground.

He had no beauty or majesty
to attract us to him,

nothing in his appearance that
we should desire him.

ISAIAH 53

³ He was despised and rejected
by mankind,

a man of suffering, and
familiar with pain.

Like one from whom people
hide their faces

he was despised, and we held
him in low esteem.

ABANDONMENT in DEATH

ISAIAH 53

- 4 Surely **he** took up **our** pain
and bore **our** suffering,
yet **we** considered **him**
punished by God,
stricken by **him**, and afflicted.
- 5 But he was pierced for our
transgressions,
he was crushed for our
iniquities;
the punishment that brought
us peace was on him,
and by his wounds we are
healed.

ISAIAH 53

⁶ We all, like sheep, have gone astray,

each of us has turned to our own way;

and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

⁷ He was oppressed and afflicted,

yet he did not open his mouth; he was led like a lamb to the slaughter,

and as a sheep before its shearers is silent,

so he did not open his mouth.

ISAIAH 53

⁸ By oppression and judgment he was taken away.

Yet who of his generation protested?

For he was cut off from the land of the living;

for the transgression of my people he was punished.

⁹ He was assigned a grave with the wicked,

and with the rich in his death, though he had done no violence,

nor was any deceit in his mouth

ATONEMENT in DEATH

PSALM 1

- ¹ Blessed is the one
who does not walk in step with
the wicked
or stand in the way that sinners
take
or sit in the company of mockers,
- ² but whose delight is in the law of
the Lord,
and who meditates on his law
day and night.
- ³ That person is like a tree planted
by streams of water,
which yields its fruit in season
and whose leaf does not wither -
whatever they do prospers.
