burdened, or troubled.



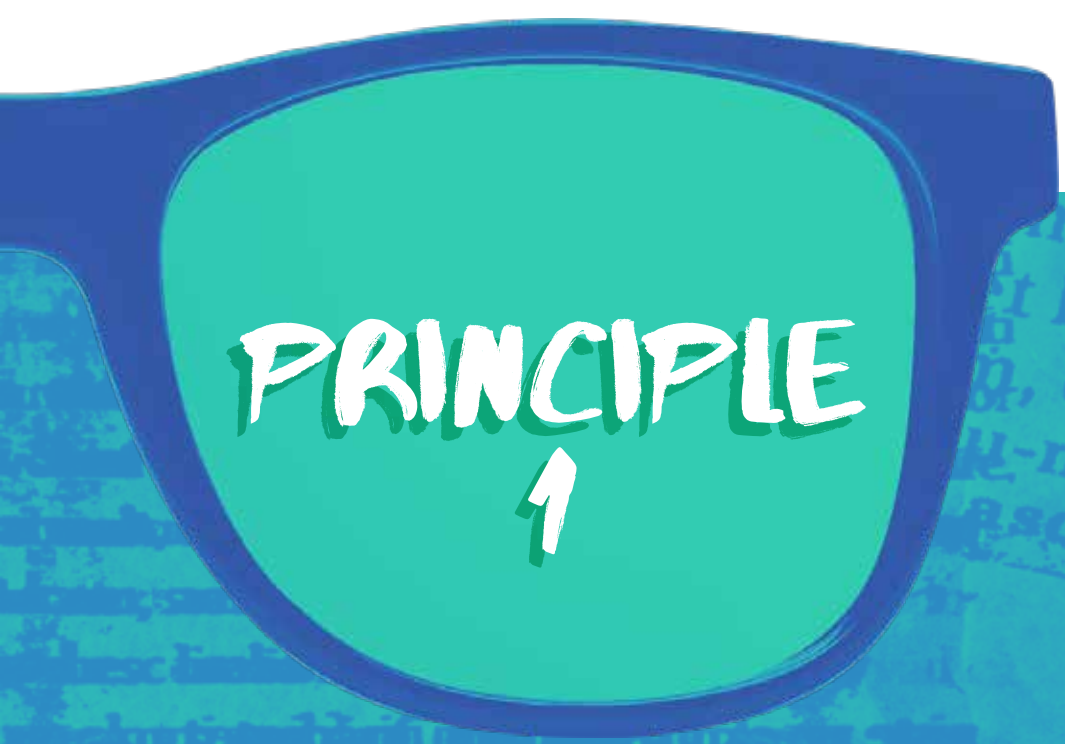

You have heard about Job's endurance and have seen the *purpose* of the Lord—that the Lord is *compassionate* and *merciful*.

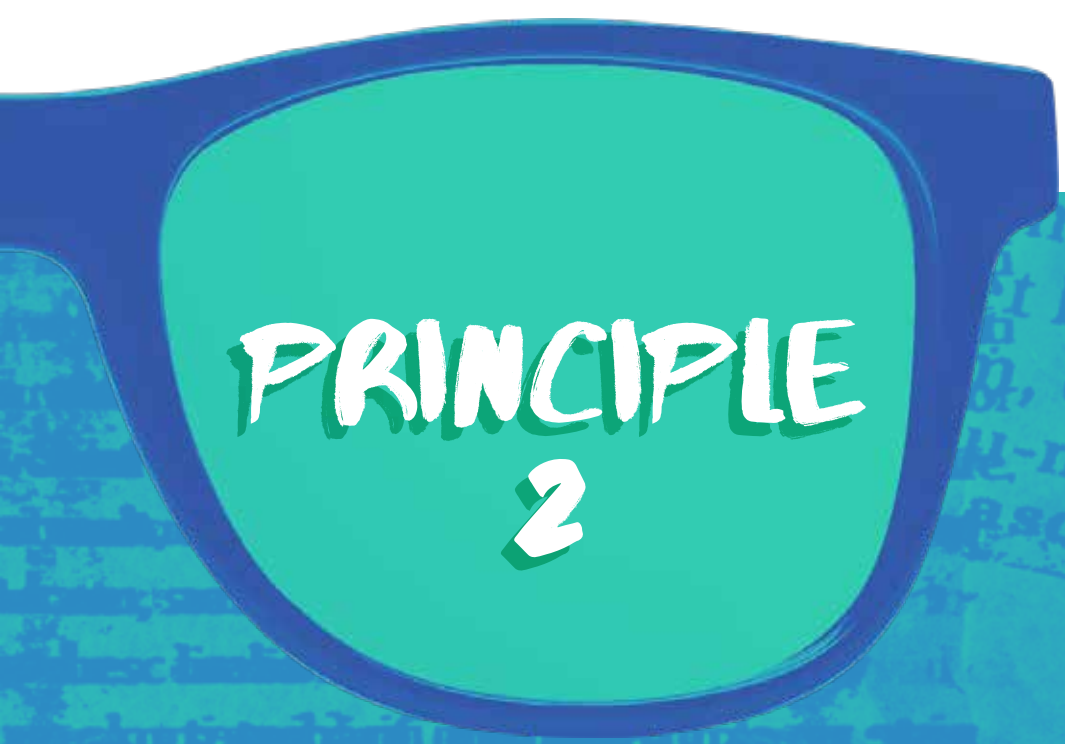
