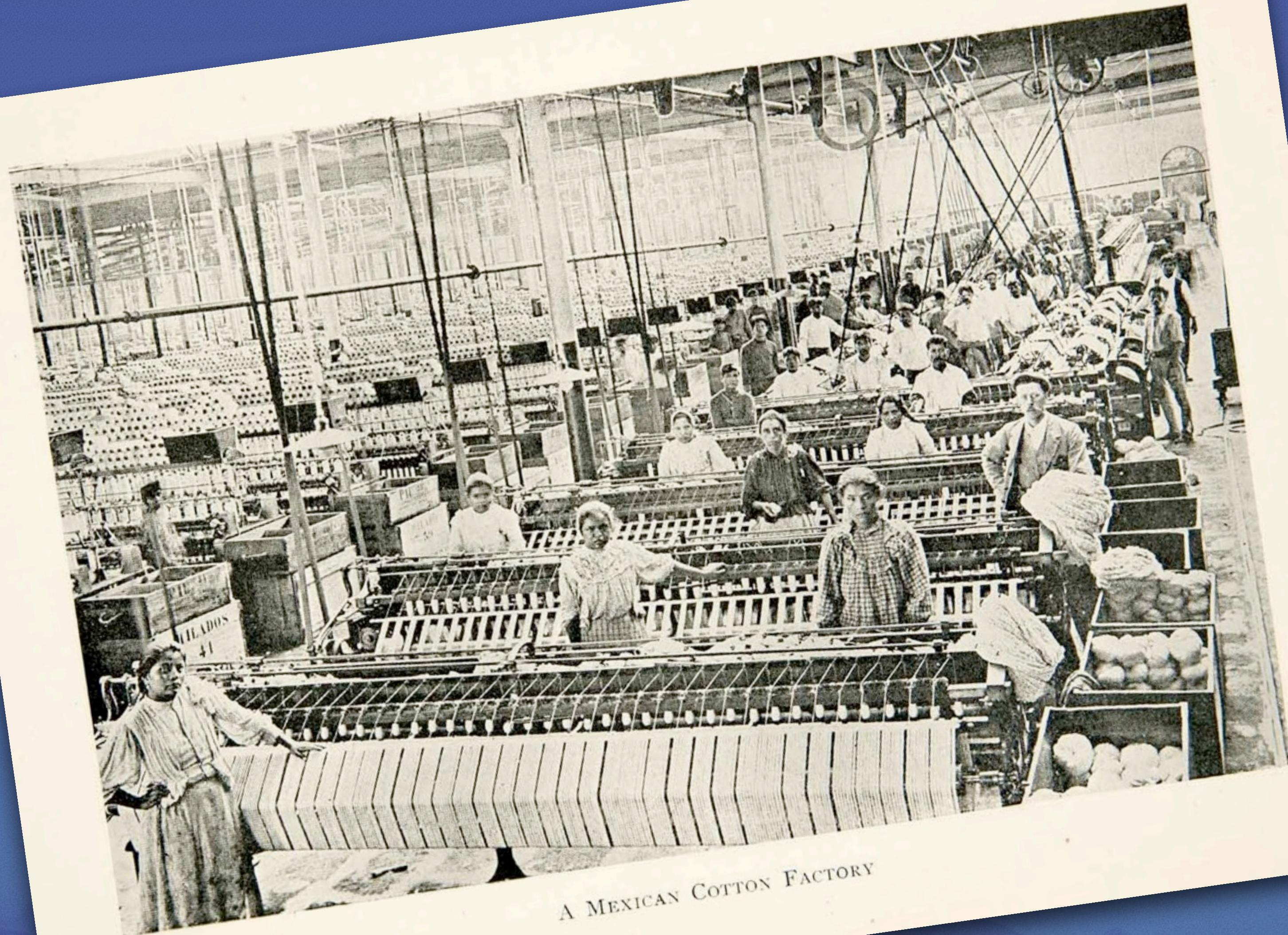

## Mark 1:29-31

<sup>29</sup>And immediately he left the synagogue and entered the house of Simon and Andrew, with James and John. <sup>30</sup>Now **Simon's mother-in-law** lay ill with a fever, and immediately they told him about her. <sup>31</sup>And **he came** and **took her by the hand** and **lifted her up**, and **the fever left her**, and **she began to serve** them.



## Mark 1:32-34

<sup>32</sup>That evening at sundown **they brought to him** all who were **sick** or **oppressed** by demons. <sup>33</sup>And **the whole city** was gathered together at the door. <sup>34</sup>And **he healed many who were sick** with various diseases, and **cast out many demons**. And he would not permit the demons to speak, because they knew him.



## Mark 2:1-5

And when he returned to Capernaum after some days, it was reported that he was at home. <sup>2</sup>And **many were gathered together**, so that there was no more room, not even at the door. And he was preaching the word to them. <sup>3</sup>And they came, bringing to him **a paralytic carried by four men**. <sup>4</sup>And when they could not get near him because of the crowd, they removed the roof above him, and when they had made an opening, they let down the bed on which the paralytic lay. <sup>5</sup>And when **Jesus saw their faith**, he said to the paralytic, “Son, your sins are forgiven.”



## Mark 2:10-12

*<sup>10</sup>But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth **to forgive sins**”—he said to the paralytic— <sup>11</sup>**“I say to you, rise, pick up** your bed, **and go home.”** <sup>12</sup>And he rose and immediately picked up his bed and went out before them all, so that they were all amazed and glorified God, saying, “We never saw anything like this!”*



## Mark 4:35-41

<sup>35</sup>On that day, when evening had come, he said to them, “Let us go across to the other side.” <sup>36</sup>And leaving the crowd, they took him with them in the boat, just as he was. And other boats were with him. <sup>37</sup>And **a great windstorm arose**, and **the waves** were **breaking into the boat**, so that the boat was already filling. <sup>38</sup>But he was in the stern, asleep on the cushion. And they woke him and said to him, “Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?”



## Mark 4:35-41

*<sup>39</sup>And he awoke and rebuked the wind and said to the sea, **“Peace! Be still!”** And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. <sup>40</sup>He said to them, “Why are you so afraid?
