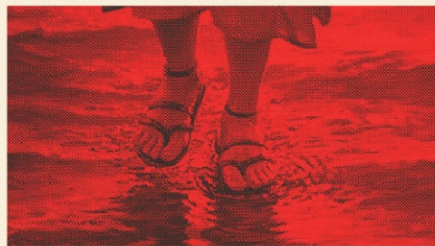

The Miracles of Jesus



John 20:30-31 ESV

³⁰ Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; ³¹ but these are written so that **you may believe** that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing **you may have life** in his name.

Jesus Heals an Official's Son

John 4:46-47 ESV


⁴⁶ So he came again to Cana in Galilee, where he had made the water wine. And at Capernaum there was an official whose son was ill. ⁴⁷ When this man heard that Jesus had come from Judea to Galilee, he went to him and asked him to come down and heal his son, for he was at the point of death.

Official/Nobleman (*Basilikos*) =
Connected with a King; Royal; Regal


The only thing he knew was that
Jesus **healed** people.

John 4:48-49 ESV

⁴⁸ So Jesus said to him, “Unless you see signs and wonders you will not **believe.**” ⁴⁹ The official said to him, “Sir, come down before my child dies.”



They were interested in Jesus because of
His miracles, not His mission.



John 4:50 ESV

⁵⁰ Jesus said to him, “Go; your son will live.” The man **believed** the word that Jesus spoke to him and went on his way.

Jesus challenged the man's faith

The man **believed** Jesus' word

He had only a promise, and he **believed**

John 4:51-54 ESV

⁵¹ As he was going down, his servants met him and told him that his son was recovering. ⁵² So he asked them the hour when he began to get better, and they said to him, “Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him.” ⁵³ The father knew that was the hour when Jesus had said to him, “Your son will live.” And he himself **believed**, and all his household. ⁵⁴ This was now the second sign that Jesus did when he had come from Judea to Galilee.

He **believed** Jesus' promise

He and his whole household **believed**
in the person of Jesus

Faith can be weak – It must be developed:

- Faith in a **Power**
 - Faith in a **Promise**
 - Faith in a **Person**

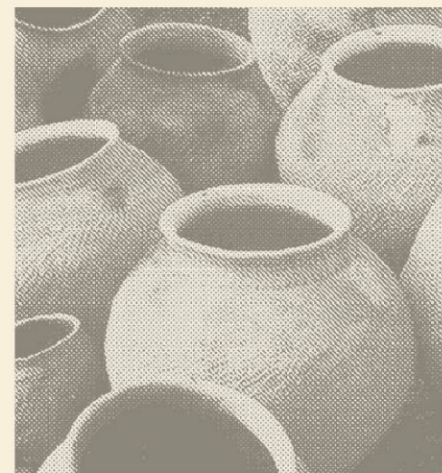
Romans 4:18-21 ESV

¹⁸ In hope he **believed** against hope, that he should become the father of many nations, as he had been told, “So shall your offspring be.” ¹⁹ He did not weaken in faith when he considered his own body, which was as good as dead (since he was about a hundred years old), or when he considered the barrenness of Sarah's womb. ²⁰ No unbelief made him waver concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong in his faith as he gave glory to God, ²¹ fully convinced that God was able to do what he had promised.

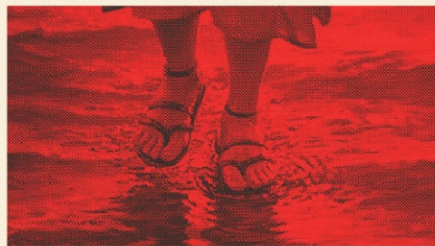
