



Zaza comes on for Chiellini

Having been brought on in the final seconds of extra-time specifically to take part in the penalty shoot-out against Germany in the quarter-finals of the Euro 2016, Simone Zaza did something that cemented his place on this list forever! The Juventus forward walked on just before the referee blew for full-time and proceeded to give instructions to his goal-keepers.

Then soon after that after both Toni Kroos and Lorenzo Insigne finished their spot kicks with ease, Zaza walked towards the spot as Manuel Neuer paced up and down the goal. The Italian picked up the ball and placed it, before looking towards the referee for confirmation and then adjusted his run-up.

The referee blew his whistle and the Juventus attacker blazed his effort over the crossbar, but only after preceding it with a staggered run-up, that has since made him a viral sensation. The fact that it was his first and only touch of the match, made everything that much worse.

However, the 25-year-old forward has insisted that he's always used that unorthodox approach to his penalties and even pointed out that, he managed to send Manuel Neuer the wrong way, despite missing the shot. Since then, the striker has been through hell, with his brief loan spell at West Ham causing him to be subject to a further figure of ridicule, before eventually moving to Valencia on loan.

The 12 Best and Worst Sugar Substitutes

Honey

Derived from the nectar bees create in their honeycombs, it takes an extraordinary amount of bees to create enough honey for humans to use. The sugars in honey are 40 percent fructose, 35 percent glucose and two percent sucrose. While honey can be used in baking, it should not replace sugar 1:1, and the liquid in the recipe must be adjusted due to the water content in honey. Honey also has a more pronounced flavor than sugar.

Although popular culture seems to believe honey is better than sugar, it is a pretty close comparison due to its composition, according a Huffington Post article. Indeed, its GI is 61, while table sugar is at 58, but it may offer some extra minerals, such as zinc and selenium.

Aspartame (Equal, NutraSweet, Sugar Twin)

Another one of the FDA-approved nonnutritive sweeteners, it is one of the most controversial artificial sweeteners and yet the most popular.

Aspartame is mostly found in soft drinks and is 180 times sweeter than sucrose. It does not elicit the same insulin response as regular sugar does in the pancreas. While there is controversy about the safety of nonnutritive sweeteners in the human diet, it seems that a portion of the population that consumes aspartame has a difficult time digesting the breakdown products of this sweetener, reporting headaches, dizziness, mood changes and nausea. Aspartame has also been linked to some cancers in some rat studies.








Man Executed for Raping and Killing 11-Month-Old Baby Girl in Oklahoma's First Lethal Injection

McALESTER, Okla. (TheBlaze/AP) — Oklahoma executed a death row inmate Thursday for raping and killing a 11-month old baby girl in 1997 in the state's first lethal injection since a botched one last spring.

Prison officials declared Charles Frederick Warner dead at 7:28 p.m. CST Thursday. The execution lasted 18 minutes.

"Before I give my final statement, I'll tell you they poked me five times. It hurt. It feels like acid," Warner said before the execution began. He added, "I'm not a monster. I didn't do everything they said I did."

After the first drug was administered, Warner said, "My body is on fire."






For generations, schoolchildren have been captivated by the magic of nature, gripped by tales from British history and fascinated by learning about our Christian traditions.


