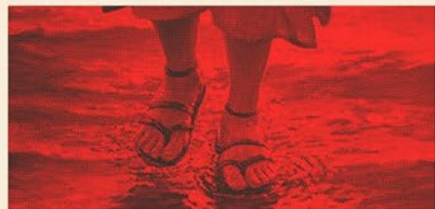


BEYOND THE SIGNS



John 20:30-31

Now Jesus did many other **signs** in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written **so that you may believe** that Jesus is the Christ (Messiah), the Son of God, and that **by believing you may have life** in His name.

The 7 signs of John's gospel

1. Wedding at Cana (He redeems us from shame)
- 2. Healing an official's son**
3. Healing at Bethesda (He is the Lord of Sabbath)

The 7 signs of John's gospel

4. Feeding of the 5,000 (He Provides)
5. Walking on Water (He Speaks to our storms)
6. Healing the blind man (He is the Light of the World)
7. Raising Lazarus from the dead (He is the Resurrection and the Life)

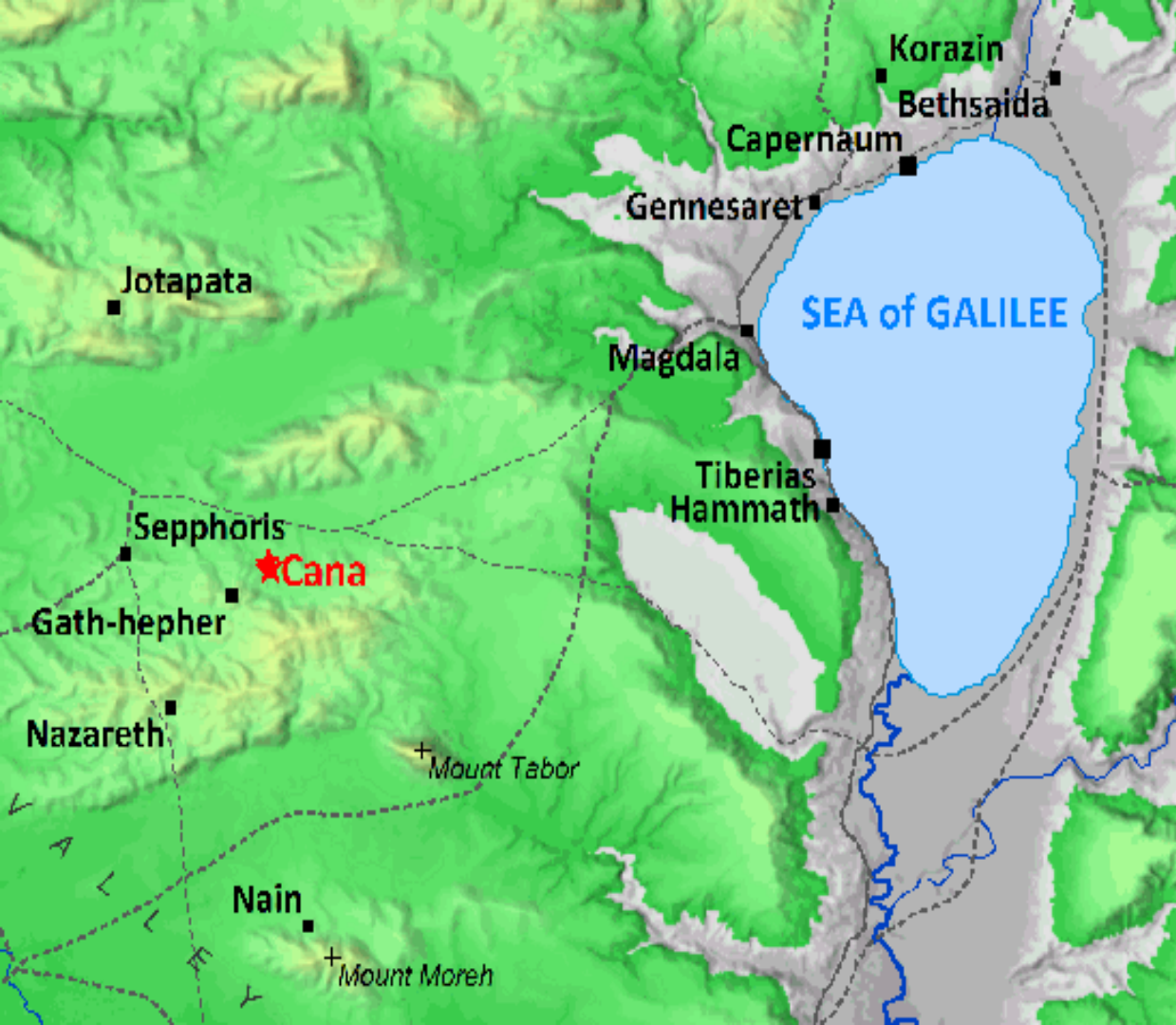
Jesus Heals an Official's son

John 4: 46-54

John 4:46

So He came again to **Can**an Galilee,
where He had made the water wine.

And at **Capernaum** there was an **official** whose
son was ill.




Cana - Capernaum

John 4:47

When this man heard that Jesus had come from Judea to Galilee, he went to Him and asked Him to come down and heal his son, for he was at the point of death.

John 4:48

So Jesus said to him, “Unless you see signs and wonders you will not believe.”

The official said to Him, “Sir, come down before my child dies.”

Isaiah 55:8-9

For My thoughts are not your thoughts,
neither are your ways My ways, declares the Lord.
For as the heavens are higher than the earth,
so are My ways higher than your ways
and My thoughts than your thoughts.

John 4:50

Jesus said to him, **Go**; your son will live.”

The man **believed** the word that Jesus spoke to him and went on his way.


At His Word,

He found a **SAVIOUR**.


FIXER = serves the needs you

As he was going down, his servants met him and told him that his son was recovering.


So he asked them the hour when he began to get better, and they said to him, "Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him."

John 4:53-54

The father knew that was the hour when Jesus had said to him, "Your son will live."

And he himself **believed** and all his household.

This was now the second sign that Jesus did when He had come from Judea to Galilee.
