Romans 12:1-2 (ESV)

I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.

Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is *good* and *acceptable (pleasing)* and *perfect*.



God's Will is:

- **Good – of the highest quality**
- **Acceptable/Pleasing - attractive**
- **Perfect – nothing to be added**

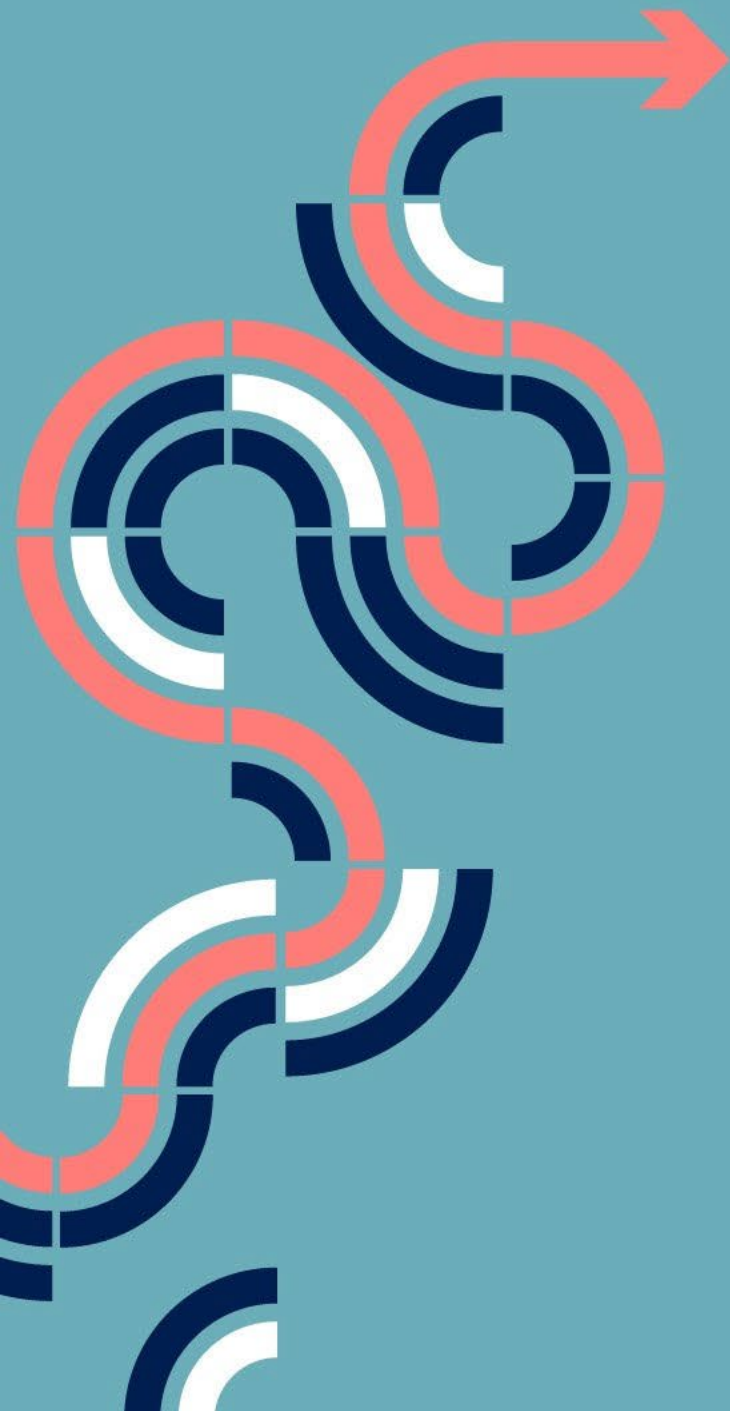
Type of God's Will

- **God's Will of Desire** → • **Missional Will of God**
→ • **Moral Will of God**
- **God's Will of Direction** → • **Personal Will of God**

Four Handles to Find the Will of God

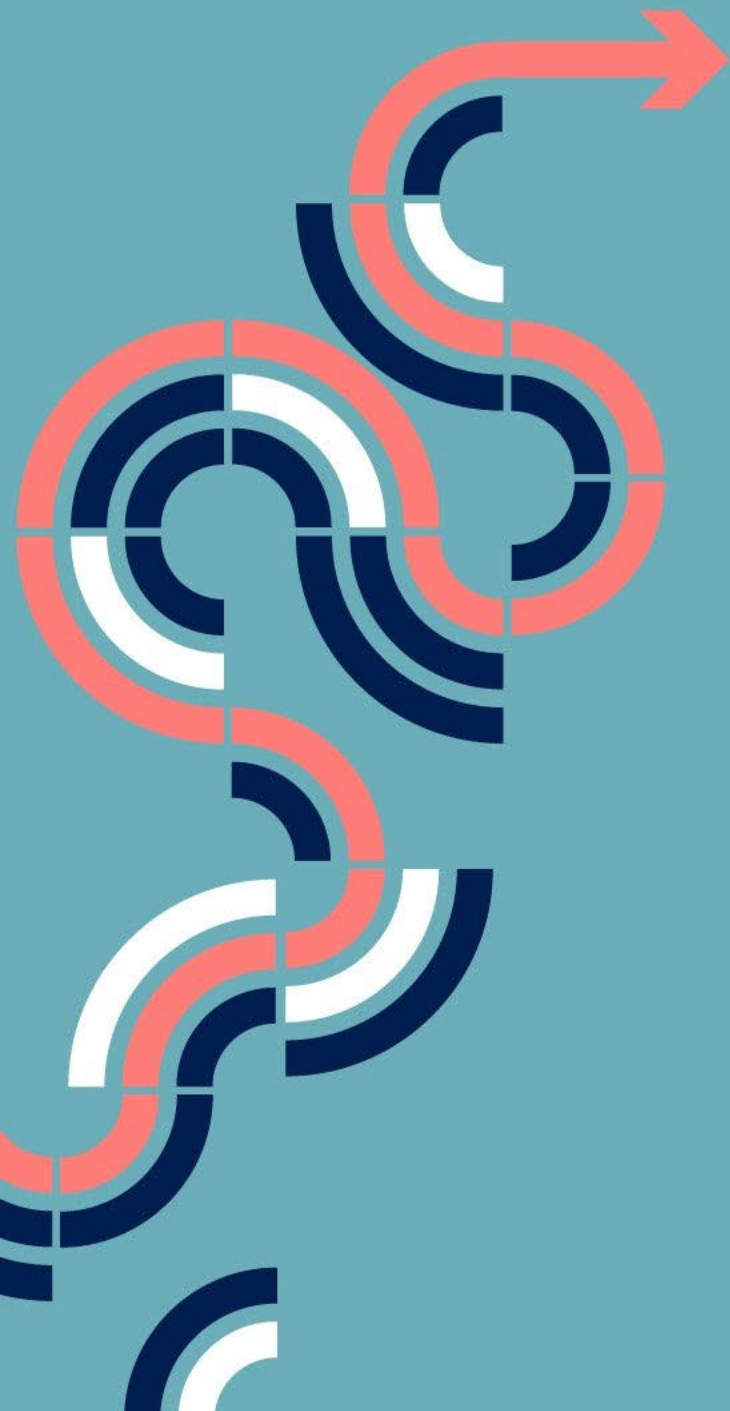
- Prayer

Philippians 4:6-7 (ESV)

Esther

- 3 - Haman vs Mordecai & Jews
- 4 - “For such a time as this”
- 5 - Sceptre, Dinner and a Pole
- 6 - Sleepless Night in the Palace of Persia
- 7 - Killing of the Jews and a Falling
- 8 - Raised in Arms



We Still Have Responsibilities

In Esther:


- **Esther obeyed Mordecai not to tell her identity**
 - **Mordecai to reported the incident**
 - **He encouraged her to see the King**
 - **Esther made her own decision with prayer and Esther risking her life to do so**
