Part 3: SANCTIFICATION by the Spirit

What is
sanctification?

SANCTIFICATION

- * related to the word **SAINT**
- * to make someone **HOLY**
- * the process of making someone **ACCEPTABLE** or **SET APART**
- * from the Greek word "**HAGIASMOS**" which means **HOLINESS** and **SEPARATION**

Why do we need
sanctification?

1 Peter 1:15-16

But as he who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, since it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy."

1 Thessalonians 4:3-5

3 For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you abstain from sexual immorality; **4** that each one of you know how to control his own body in holiness and honor, **5** not in the passion of lust like the Gentiles who do not know God;

Who does the
sanctification?

Romans 15:16

to be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles, ministering as a priest the gospel of God, so that my offering of the Gentiles may become acceptable, sanctified by the Holy Spirit.

To *receíve* the HOLY SPIRIT



SALVATION

Galatians 3:1-2

¹ O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? It was before your eyes that Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified. ² Let me ask you only this: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith?

1 Corinthian 6:11

And such were some of you. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.

To be *perfected* by the HOLY SPIRIT

PERFECTION

Galatians 3:3-4

³ Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh? ⁴ Did you suffer so many things in vain—if indeed it was in vain?

1 Thessalonians 5:23

Now may the God of peace himself sanctify you
completely, and may your whole spirit and
soul and body be kept blameless at the coming
of our Lord Jesus Christ.

MAKE ROOM

To be *glorified* with the HOLY SPIRIT



GLORIFICATION

Galatians 3:5-6

5 Does he who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you do so by works of the law, or by hearing with faith 6 just as Abraham “believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness”?

Galatians 3:8-9

⁸ And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed." ⁹ So then, those who are of faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith.

Romans 8:29-30

29 For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. 30 And those whom he predestined he also called, and those whom he called he also justified, and those whom he justified he also glorified.
