

In the first book, O Theophilus, I have dealt with all that Jesus began to do and teach, until the day when he was taken up, after he had given commands through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. The Greek word for WAIT = "perimeno", which means to stay around, to wait and to expect.

It came from 2 root word:

- "Peri": about, concerning, on account of, because of, around, near;
- •"meno": to remain, abide; not to depart, to continue to be present; to be held, kept, continually, to last to endure; in reference to time; to survive, to live;
- •So "Perimeno" means to remain in a place and/or state, with expectancy concerning a future event;
