3 Myths : 3 Mistaken Ideas of Living Morally






I. Myth of Licentiousness

2. Myth of Legalism




Colossians 2:23 ESV

"These rules may seem wise because they require strong devotion, pious self-denial, and severe bodily discipline. But they provide no help in conquering a person's evil desires."




3. Myth of Moralism




Colossians 3:1-4 ESV






I. PUT OFF : Put something to DEATH










2. PUT ON : Put something ON


