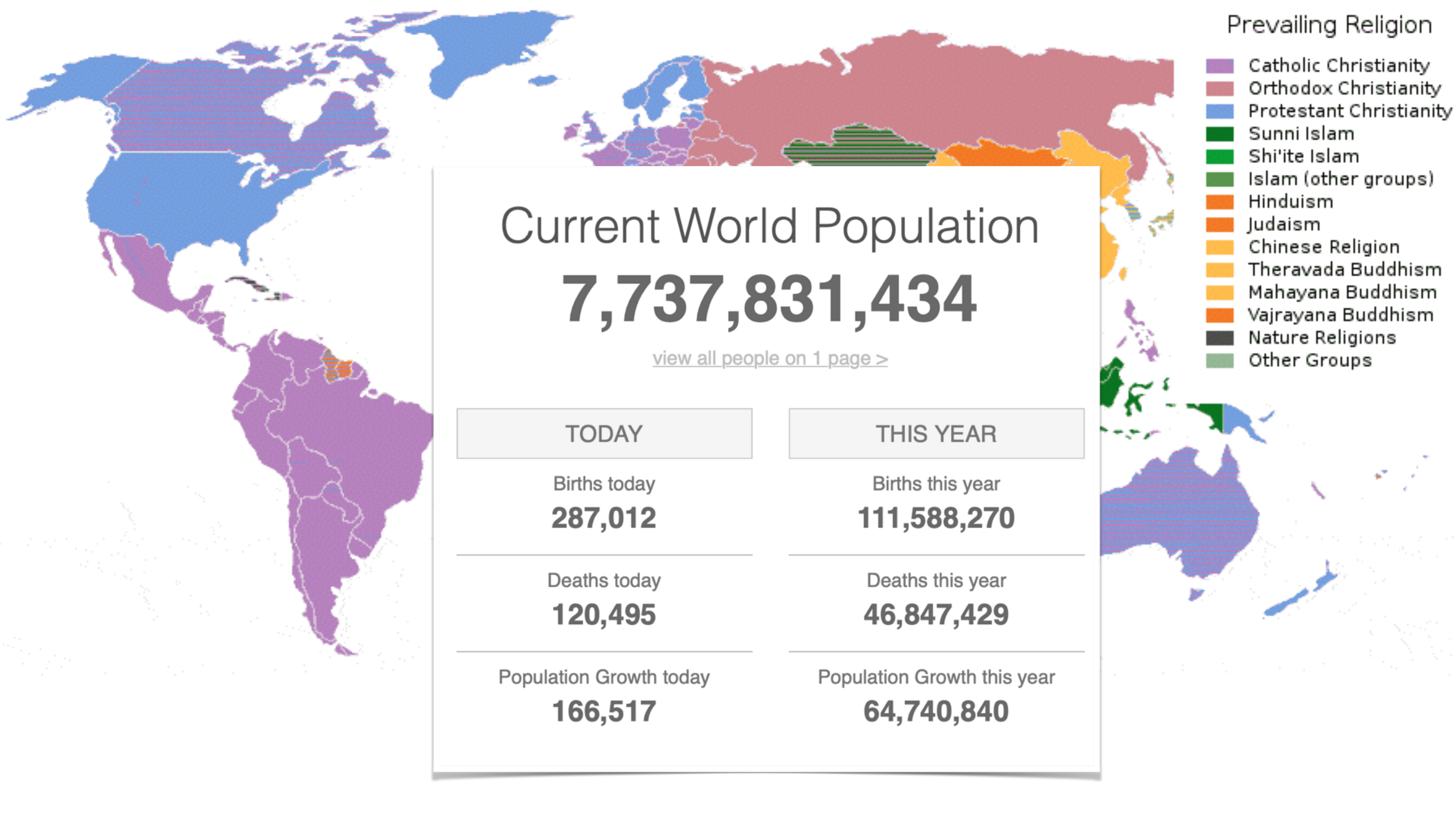



Colossians 4:2 ESV

Gk = “proskatereo” which means

“to be courageously persistent, be constantly diligent, do not let go, persevere and not to faint;” “to continue to do something with intense effort, with the possible implication of despite difficulty – ‘to devote oneself to, to keep on, to persist in’”

Gk = grégoreó: to be awake (stay awake), to watch; to be alert and expectant in faith;

Gk = eucharistia:





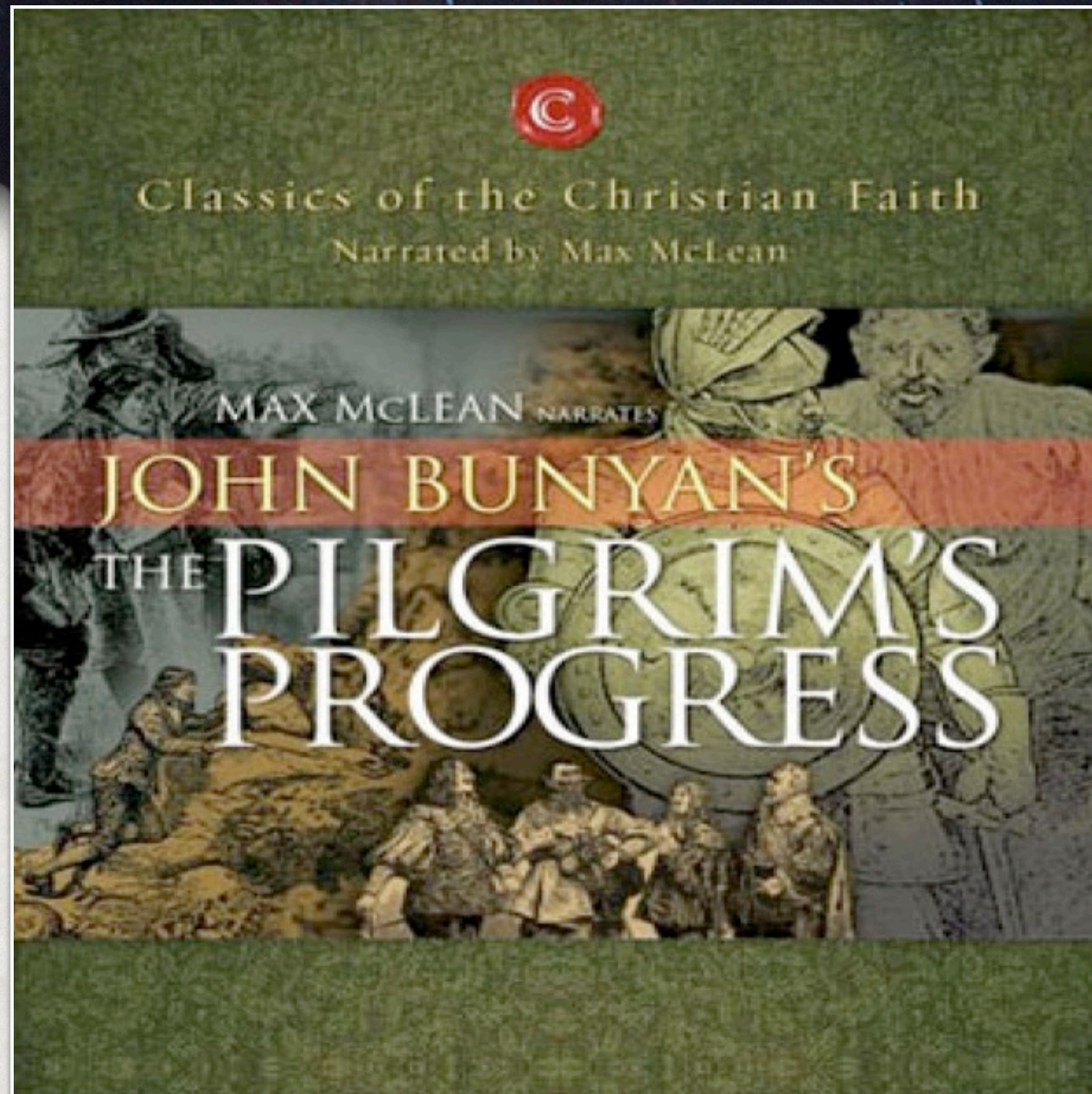
