




WHAT IS A MISSIONAL CHRISTIAN?


Gk = **grégoreó**: to be awake (stay awake), to watch; to be alert and expectant in faith;


Gk = eucharistia:







When was arrested for preaching illegally and put into prison, he was told that he would be released if he promised to stop preaching.




