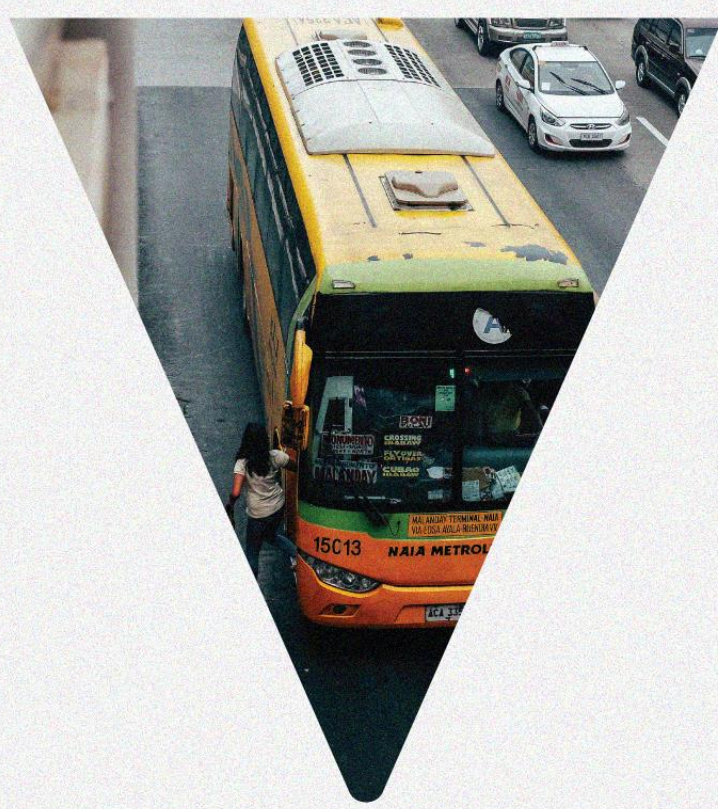

# Objective

# Backstory

- Abram was the son of Terah from Ur of the Chaldeans.
- Abram's wife is Sarai and he has a nephew named Lot.
- On their journey to Canaan they settled in Haran.
- When Terah died at the age of 205, God instructed Abram to go to the promised land, make him into a great nation, bless and make his name great. (Gen. 12:1-3)
- Abram obeyed the Lord took his wife Sarai, his nephew Lot, and all their possessions and went to the land of Canaan. (Gen. 12:4-5)
- Built his first altar at the oak of Moreh and the second at the east of Bethel.



# Backstory

- There was famine in the land so He went to Egypt. (Gen. 12:10)
- Instructed Sarai his wife to tell the Egyptians she was his sister so they will not kill him and let them live. (Gen. 12:11-14)
- Sarai was taken to Pharaoh's house and in return Abram was given livestock and servants. (Gen. 12-15-16)
- But the Lord afflicted Pharaoh's and his house with great plagues because of Sarai, and thus Abram was sent away and all He has. (Gen. 12:17-20)

# Purpose # 1: BELIEVE IN GOD

Romans 4:3 (NKJV)

What does Scripture say? “**Abraham believed God**, and it was credited to him as righteousness.”

# Purpose # 2: OBEY GOD

Hebrews 11:8 (NKJV)

By faith **Abraham obeyed** when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going.

## James 2:21-23 (NKJV)

<sup>21</sup> Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered Isaac his son on the altar?

<sup>22</sup> **Do you see that faith was working together with his works, and by works faith was made perfect?**

<sup>23</sup> And the Scripture was fulfilled which says, “Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.” And he was called the friend of God.

## Gen. 13:10-11

<sup>10</sup> And **Lot lifted up his eyes and saw that the Jordan Valley was well watered everywhere like the garden of the LORD, like the land of Egypt**, in the direction of Zoar. (This was before the LORD destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah.)

<sup>11</sup> So **Lot chose for himself** all the Jordan Valley, and Lot journeyed east. Thus they separated from each other.
