

Overview of the Gospel of Luke


- Longest book among the 4 Gospels and the longest book of the New Testament.
- A compilation, a narrative, and accurate chronological understanding of Jesus' life, ministry, death, and resurrection.
- An eyewitness testimonies of the people who witnessed the life of Jesus.
- Written for Theophilus who is a Gentile Christian to guide him and other believers about the things that has been taught to them about Jesus.

The 3 Scenes in the Birth of Jesus Christ and discover why Jesus is the for all. (Luke 1:1-21)


Scene 1: The Decree

Scene 3: The Field




Scene 1: The Decree



Luke 2:1-5 ESV

1 In those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered. 2 This was the first registration when Quirinius was governor of Syria.





Luke 2:1-5 ESV

3 And all went to be registered, each to his own town.

4 And Joseph also went up from Galilee, from the town of Nazareth, to Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David,

5 to be registered with Mary, his betrothed, who was with child.



BETHLEHEM means "House of Bread"




Point No. 1 Jesus the Bread of Life



John 8:32-35 ESV

32 Jesus then said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, it was not Moses who gave you the bread from heaven, but my Father gives you the true bread from heaven. 33 For the bread of God is he who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world." 34 They said to him, "Sir, give us this bread always." 35 <u>Jesus said</u> to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in me shall never thirst.

Scene 2: The Manger



Luke 2:6-7 ESV

6 And while they were there, the time came for her to give birth.

7 And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in swaddling cloths and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the inn.






Point No. 2 Jesus the Humble Servant



Philippians 2:6-8 ESV

- 6 who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped,
- 7 but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.
- 8 And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Scene 3: The Field



Luke 2:8-9 ESV

8 And in the same region there were shepherds out in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. 9 And an angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were filled with great fear.





Luke 2:10-11 ESV

10 And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people.

11 For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord.
