Grace:

Unmerited favour;
all the unearned, undeserved
good things that comes our way.

1. God's Grace is much more than what we have done.

V15 – For if many died through one man's trespass, **much more** have the **grace of God** and the free gift by the **grace of that one man Jesus Christ** abounded for many.


2. God's Grace is much more than what we deserve.

V16 – For the judgement following one trespass bought condemnation, but the **free gift** following many trespasses brought **justification**.

3. God's Grace is much more than what we fear.

V17 – For if, because of one man's trespass, death reigned through that one man, how **much more** will those who receive the **abundance of grace** and the free gift of righteousness **reign in life** through the one man Jesus Christ.

Grace is a gift that we deserve
the least, but it's a gift that we
needed the most.

GRACE is NOT FAIR,

Romans 5:20-21
