Who is Enoch?

- The son of Jared (2nd oldest man who lived)
- The father of Methuselah (Oldest man who lived)
- The great grandfather of Noah (3rd oldest man who lived)
- He is one of the ancestors in the genealogy of Jesus Christ (Luke 3:37)
- He pleased God. (Heb. 11:5)
- He had great faith. (Heb. 11:6)
- He was a prophet before man. (Jude 14)
- He had a glorious exit from earth. (Heb. 11:5)
- He **WALKED** with God for 300 years. (Gen. 5:22)

1 Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; **2 but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and night.**



#3 Great Faith proclaims Jesus to the world everyday.

Jude 14-15 (ESV)

14 It was also about these that **Enoch**, the seventh from Adam, **prophesied**, saying, “Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of his holy ones, **15** to execute judgment on all and to convict all the ungodly of all their deeds of ungodliness that they have committed in such an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things that ungodly sinners have spoken against him.”



Methuselah

Enoch named his son to reflect this prophecy. The name Methuselah comes from two roots: **muth**, a root that means “**death**” ; and from **shalach**, which means “**to bring,**” or “**to send forth.**”
Thus, the name Methuselah signifies,
“his death shall bring.”
