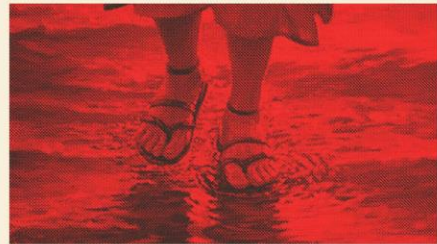
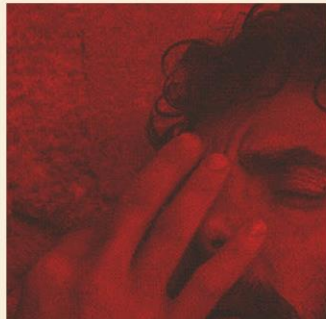

<sup>16</sup> When evening came, his **disciples** went down to the sea, <sup>17</sup> got into a boat, and started across the sea to Capernaum. It was now dark, and Jesus had not yet come to them. <sup>18</sup> The sea became rough because a strong wind was blowing. <sup>19</sup> When they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus walking on the sea and coming near the boat, and they were frightened. <sup>20</sup> But he said to them, "**It is I; do not be afraid.**" <sup>21</sup> Then they were glad to take him into the boat, and immediately the boat was at the land to which they were going.

# The Storm – Implications

## Mark 6:47-48a ESV

<sup>47</sup> And when evening came, the boat was **out on the sea**, and he was alone on the land. <sup>48</sup> And he saw that they were **making headway painfully**, for the wind was against them. And about the **fourth watch** of the night he came to them, walking on the sea. . . . .

- Disciples were thrown off-course: Rowed double the distance
  - Disciples were toiling painfully: 9 hours of rowing vs 30 minutes of walking

# The Storm – Why did Jesus have to walk on water?

- Demonstrates that Jesus is with us in the storm
- Demonstrates that Jesus overcomes the storm

**John 6:20 ESV**

## **The Storm – Why did they not recognise Jesus?**

**Mark 6:51-52 ESV**

<sup>51</sup> And he got into the boat with them, and the wind ceased. And they were utterly astounded, <sup>52</sup> for they did not understand about the loaves, but their hearts were hardened.

# The Response of the Disciples

## John 6:66-69 ESV

<sup>66</sup> After this many of his disciples turned back and no longer walked with him. <sup>67</sup> So Jesus said to the Twelve, "**Do you want to go away as well?**" <sup>68</sup> Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life, <sup>69</sup> and we have believed, and have come to know, that you are the Holy One of God."

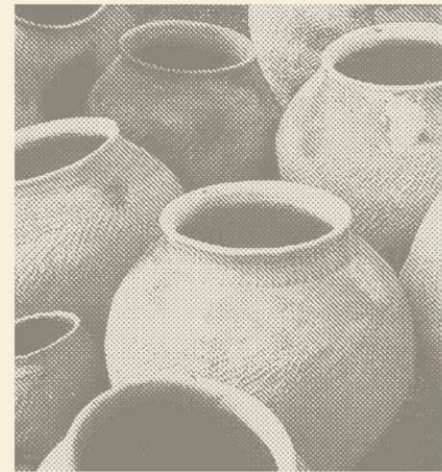
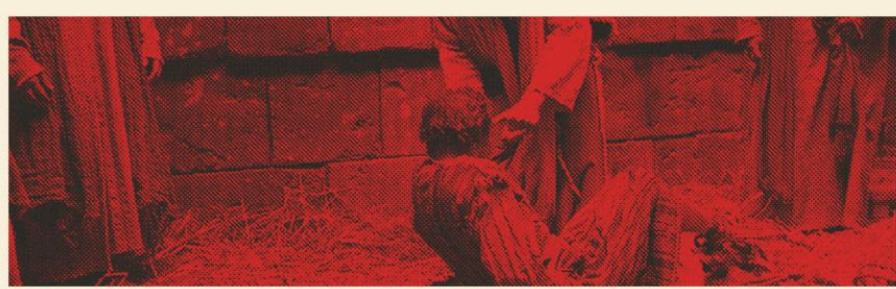
