


The following night the Lord stood near Paul and said, "Take courage! As you have testified about me in Jerusalem, so you must also testify in Rome."







<sup>22</sup> But now I urge you to keep up your courage, because not one of you will be lost; only the ship will be destroyed. <sup>23</sup> Last night an angel of the God **to whom I belong and whom I serve** stood beside me <sup>24</sup> and said, **'Do not be afraid, Paul. You must stand trial before Caesar; and God has graciously given you the lives of all who sail with you.'** <sup>25</sup> So keep up your courage, men, **for I have faith in God** that it will happen just as he told me. <sup>26</sup> Nevertheless, we must run aground on some island."
