
"God eternally exists as 3 Persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and each person is fully God and there is one God." (Grudem, 226)

God is eternally one essence, yet exists eternally in three distinct Persons; revealed to us as Father, Son and Holy Spirit; distinguishable but indivisible in essence; co-equal in nature, attributes, and glory, so that each is Fully God, yet not apart from the others, for each coinheres in (interpenetrates) the others; without hierarchy in essence, yet hierarchical in function with each person fulfilling distinct roles. The divine Trinity is neither one Person revealed in three different modes, not three gods in union, but is one God in three Persons.

Acts 9:1-7 ESV

And it happened that while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul passed through the inland, country and came to Ephesus. There he found some disciples. And he said to them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?"

And they said, "No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit." And he said, "Into what then were you baptized?" They said, "Into John's baptism."

Acts 19:4-7 ESV

And Paul said, "John baptized with the baptism of repentance, telling the people **to believe** in the one who was to come after him, that is, Jesus."

On hearing this, **they were baptized** in the name of the Lord Jesus. And when Paul had laid his hands on them, **the Holy Spirit came** on them, and they began speaking in tongues and prophesying. There were about twelve men in all.

Acts 5:1-6 ESV

But a man named **Ananias**, with his wife **Sapphira**, sold a piece of property, and with his wife's knowledge **he kept back** for himself some of the proceeds and **brought only a part** of it and laid it at the apostles' feet. But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart **to lie** to the Holy Spirit and to keep back for yourself part of the proceeds of the land?

While it remained unsold, did it not remain your own? And after it was sold, was it not at your disposal? Why is it that you have contrived this deed in your heart? You have not lied to man but to God."
