




UNDERSTANDING GRACE OF GOD

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Romans 5:12-21

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¹² Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all people, because all sinned—, To be sure, sin was in the world before the law was given, but sin is not charged against anyone's account where there is no law. "Nevertheless, death reigned from the time of Adam to the time of Moses, even over those who did not sin by breaking a command, as did Adam, who is a pattern of the one to come.




GRACE REIGNS THROUGH CHRIST

Romans 5:15-19

The First Adam

One man trespass, many died: V15

Judgement and condemnation: V16

Death reign through one man: V17

One **trespass** brought condemnation :V18

One man's **disobedience** made many sinners: V19

The Second ADAM

V15: One man with God's gracious gift; overflow and **saved** many;


V16: Justification;

V17: Gift of righteousness Reign in Life

through one man; Jesus Christ;

V18: One **righteous** act brought justification;

V19: One man's **obedience** made many righteous;



GRACE TRIUMPH OVER SIN & DEATH

Romans 5:20-21

The First Adam


Was made of the **earth**Was king of the **old** creation
