Grace of God

1. Death reigns through Adam
(Rom. 5:12-14)
2. Grace reigns through Christ
(Rom. 5:15-19)
3. Grace triumphs over sin & death
(Rom. 5:20-21)



Romans 5:12-21

Grace of God

1. God's grace is **FREE** (Rom. 5:15)
2. God's grace leads to **JUSTIFICATION** (Rom. 5:16,18)
3. God's grace is **ABUNDANT** (Rom. 5:17)
4. God's grace leads to **ETERNAL LIFE** (Rom. 5:17,18)

Romans 6:1-4 ESV

¹ What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound?

² By no means! How can we who died to sin still live in it?

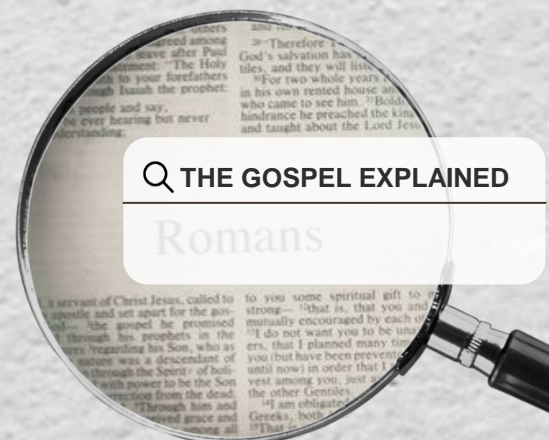
Key Point A:

Baptized into Jesus Christ

(Romans 6:1-4)

Baptize

"to administer the rite of baptism to," c. 1300, from Old French *batisier* "be baptized; baptize; give a name to" (11c.), from Latin *baptizare*, from Greek *baptizein* "immerse, dip in water," also figuratively, "be over one's head" (in debt, etc.), "to be soaked (in wine);" in Christian use, "baptize;" from *baptein* "to dip, steep, dye, color," perhaps from PIE root **gwabh-* (1) "to dip, sink." Christian baptism originally was a full immersion. Related: *Baptized; baptizing*.



Romans 6:3-4 ESV

³ Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were **baptized into his death?**

⁴ We were **buried therefore with him** by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was **raised from the dead** by the glory of the Father, we too might **walk in newness of life.**

What does it mean to be baptized into Jesus Christ?

A.1: Died with Christ.

A.2: Buried with Christ

A.3: Raised with Christ





Romans 6:3 "all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death"



Died with Christ



Romans 6:4 "we were therefore buried with him through baptism into death"



Buried with Christ



Romans 6:4 "just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life"

Key Point B:

United with Jesus Christ

(Romans 6:5-10)

United

early 15c. (transitive), from Late Latin *unitus*, past participle of *unire* "to unite, make into one" (transitive), from Latin *unus* "one" (from PIE root *oi-no- "one, unique"). Intransitive sense from 1610s.



Romans 6:5 ESV

For if we have been **united with him** in a death like his, we shall certainly be **united with him** in a resurrection like his.

Why is it important to be united with Jesus Christ?

Point B.1:

United with Jesus through death and resurrection.



Romans 6:6,7 ESV

⁶ We know that our old self was **crucified with him** in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would **no longer be enslaved to sin.** ⁷ For one who has died has been **set free from sin.**

Why is it important to be united with Jesus Christ?

Point B.2:

Crucified with Jesus so we could be set free from sin.



SINS



Romans 6:8,9 ESV

⁸ Now if we have **died with Christ**, we believe that we will also **live with him.** ⁹ We know that **Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again**; death no longer has dominion over him.

Why is it important to be united with Jesus Christ?

Point B.3:

Died with Jesus so we could have eternal life.

Key Point C:

Alive to Jesus Christ

(Romans 6:11-14)





**How should
we live for
Jesus Christ?**

Romans 6:11 ESV

¹¹ So you also must **consider yourselves dead to sin** and alive to God in Christ Jesus.

Point C.1:

**Consider yourself
dead to sin.**



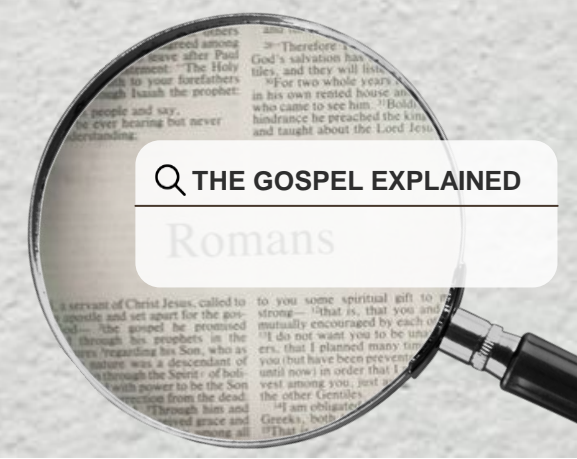
**How should

Romans 6:12 ESV

12 Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions.

Point C.2:

Do not let sin reign in your body.



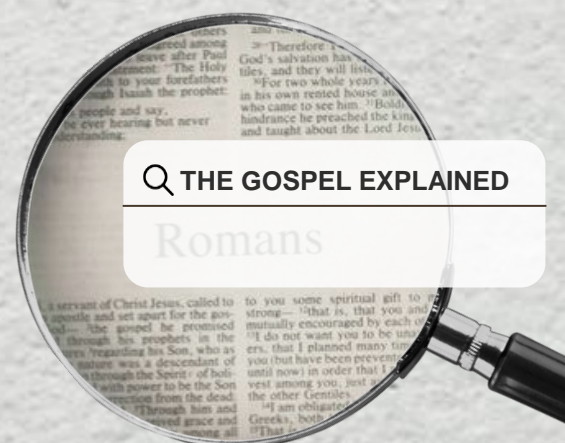
**How should

Jesus Christ?**

Romans 6:13 ESV

¹³ Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but **present yourselves to God** as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as **instruments for righteousness.**

Point C.3:

Present yourself to God as instruments for righteousness.

Romans 6:14 ESV

¹⁴ For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but **under grace.**

Point C.4:

**Live under God's
grace each day.**

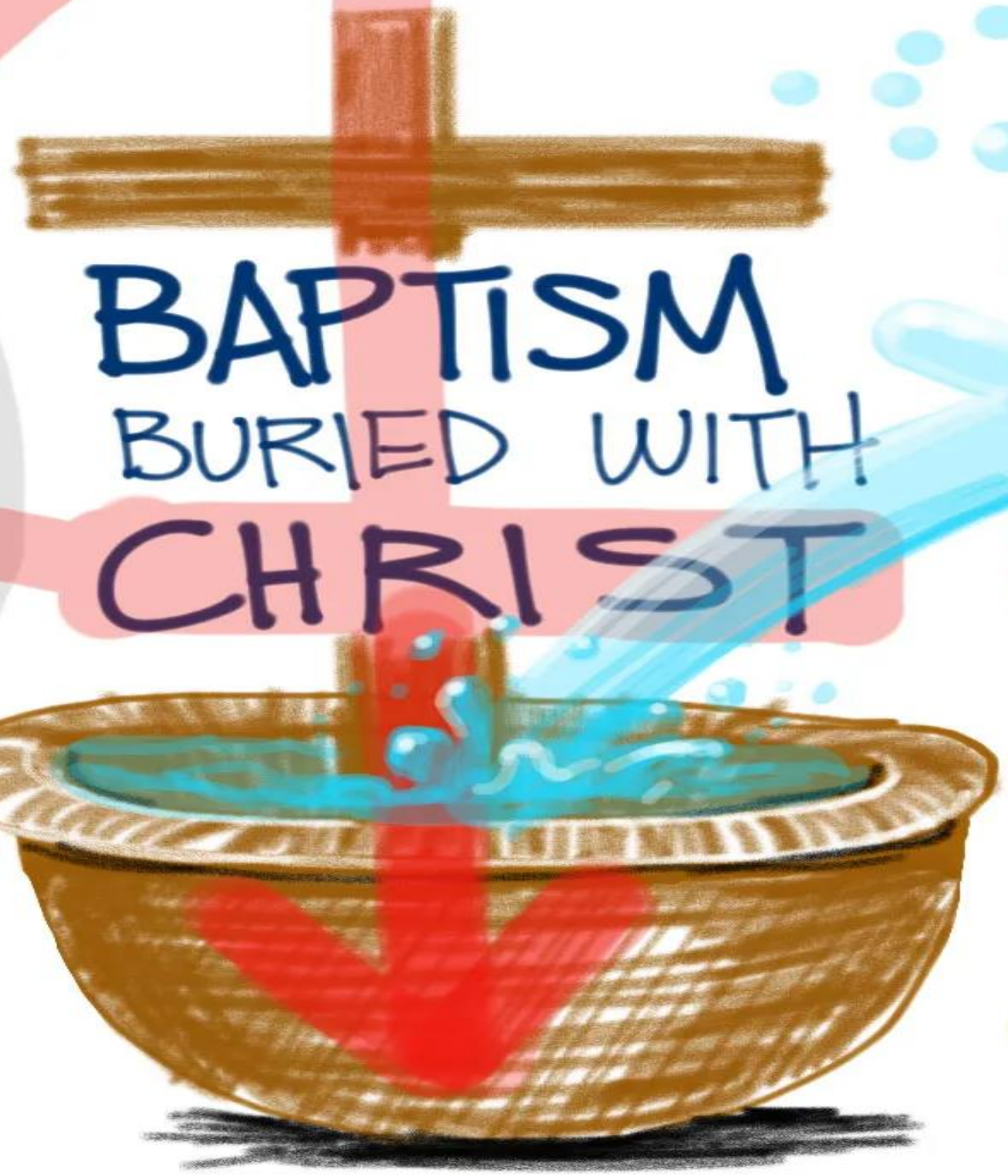
