








A LIFE WORTH LIVING TOUS IS ALWAYS EXTERNAL TO US

UNDERSTANDING ROMAN SEXUALITY


It was expected and socially acceptable for a freeborn Roman man to want sex with both female and male partners, as long as he took the dominating role.

UNDERSTANDING ROMAN SEXUALITY

Acceptable objects of desire were women of social or legal status, male prostitutes, or male slaves, but sexual behaviors outside marriage were to be confined to slaves and prostitutes, or less often a concubine or "kept woman".

 Slaves were regarded as property and could be used by their masters for sex






