





- Apply the power of the Gospel and its implication for our lives.




#### MAP OF MALAYSIA

### God's Choice is Sovereign




#### Romans 9:10-13 NIV


# God's Mercy is Sovereign



#### Romans 9:14-18 NIV

<sup>15</sup> For he says to Moses, "I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion."


<sup>16</sup> It does not, therefore, depend on human desire or effort, but on God's mercy.




#### Romans 9:14-18 NIV






#### **Characteristic 3:**

## God's Purpose is Sovereign




#### Romans 9:19-21 NIV




Answer:


## God's Kindness is Sovereign



#### Romans 11:22-23 NIV




### God's Gift is Sovereign



#### Romans 11:28-29 NIV


<sup>28</sup> As far as the gospel is concerned, they are enemies for your sake; but as far as election is concerned, they are loved on account of the patriarchs,

# God's Wisdom & Knowledge is Sovereign





#### Romans 6:23 NIV


