The Stories of :

- **Jesus Raises JAIRUS' DAUGHTER**  
=> Luke 8:40-56



## Luke 8:40-42 ESV

<sup>40</sup> Now when Jesus returned, the crowd welcomed him, for they were all waiting for him.

<sup>41</sup> And there came a man named Jairus, who was **a ruler of the synagogue**. And falling at Jesus' feet, he implored him to come to his house, <sup>42</sup>for he had an **only daughter**, about **twelve years** of age, and **she was dying**.

## Luke 8:49-50 ESV

<sup>49</sup> While he was still speaking, someone from the ruler's house came and said, "**Your daughter is dead**; do not trouble the Teacher any more."

<sup>50</sup> But Jesus on hearing this answered him, "Do not fear; only believe, and she will be well."

## Luke 8:52-55 ESV

<sup>52</sup>And all were weeping and mourning for her, but he said, "Do not weep, **for she is not dead** but sleeping." <sup>53</sup>And they **laughed** at him, **knowing** that **she was dead**. <sup>54</sup>But taking her by the hand he called, saying, "Child, arise." <sup>55</sup>And **her spirit returned**, and **she got up at once**. And he directed that something should be given her to eat.

## Luke 7:11-17 ESV

<sup>11</sup> Soon afterward he went to **a town called Nain**, and his disciples and a great crowd went with him. <sup>12</sup> As he drew near to the gate of the town, behold, **a man who had died** was being carried out, **the only son of his mother**, and she was **a widow**, and a considerable crowd from the town was with her. <sup>13</sup> And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her and said to her, "Do not weep."

## Luke 7:14-17 ESV

<sup>14</sup> **Then he came up and touched the bier, and the bearers stood still. And he said, "Young man, I say to you, arise."** <sup>15</sup> **And the dead man sat up and began to speak, and Jesus gave him to his mother.** <sup>16</sup> **Fear seized them all, and they glorified God, saying, "A great prophet has arisen among us!" and "God has visited his people!"** <sup>17</sup> **And this report about him spread through the whole of Judea and all the surrounding country.**

## John 11:17-19 ESV

<sup>17</sup> Now when **Jesus** came, he **found** that **Lazarus** had already been **in the tomb four days**.

<sup>18</sup> Bethany was near Jerusalem, about **two miles off**, <sup>19</sup> and many of the Jews had come to Martha and Mary to console them concerning their brother.



## John 11:21-27 ESV

<sup>21</sup> **Martha said to Jesus,** “Lord, **if** you had been here, my brother would not have died. <sup>22</sup> **But** even now I know that whatever you ask from God, God will give you.”

<sup>23</sup> Jesus said to her, “Your brother will rise again.”

<sup>24</sup> **Martha said to him,** “I know that he will rise again in the resurrection on the last day.”

## John 11:25-27 ESV

<sup>25</sup> Jesus said to her, **"I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, <sup>26</sup> and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die. Do you believe this?"** <sup>27</sup> She said to him, **"Yes, Lord; I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, who is coming into the world."**

Acts 1:8 ESV

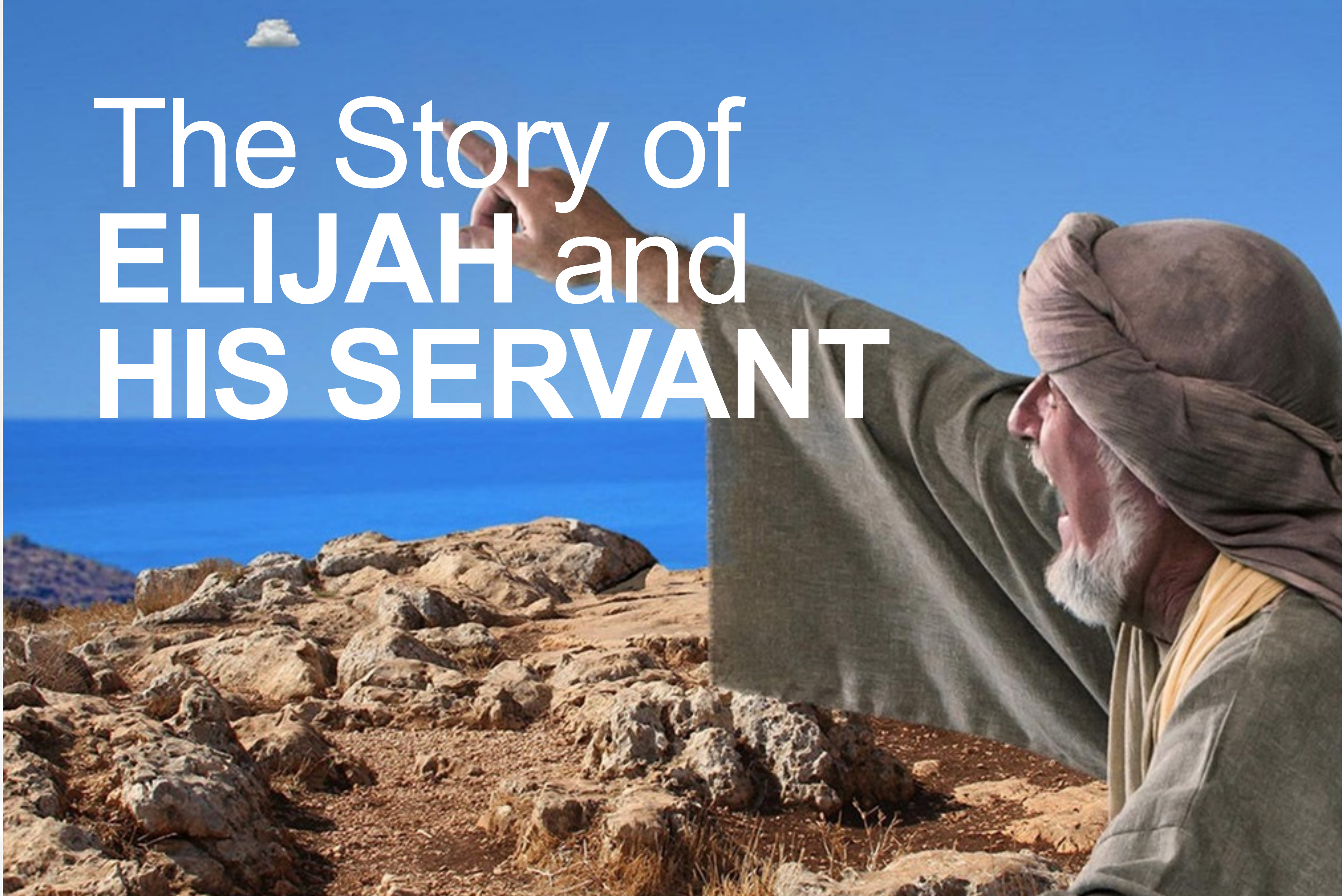

## 1 Kings 18:41-43 ESV

<sup>41</sup> Then Elijah said to Ahab, "Go up, eat and drink; for there is **the sound of abundance of rain.**" <sup>42</sup> So Ahab went up to eat and drink. And Elijah **went up** to the top of Carmel; then he **bowed down** on the ground, and put his face **between his knees,** <sup>43</sup> and **said to his servant,** "Go up now, look toward the sea." So he went up and looked, and said, "**There is nothing.**" And **seven times** he said, "Go again."

1 Kings 18:44-46 ESV

<sup>44</sup> *Then **it came to pass the seventh time**, that he said, "**There is a cloud, as small as a man's hand, rising out of the sea!**" So he said, "Go up, say to Ahab, 'Prepare your chariot, and go down before the rain stops you.' "*

## 1 Kings 18:45-46 ESV

<sup>45</sup> Now it happened in the meantime that **the sky became black with clouds and wind**, and there was **a heavy rain**. So Ahab rode away and went to Jezreel.

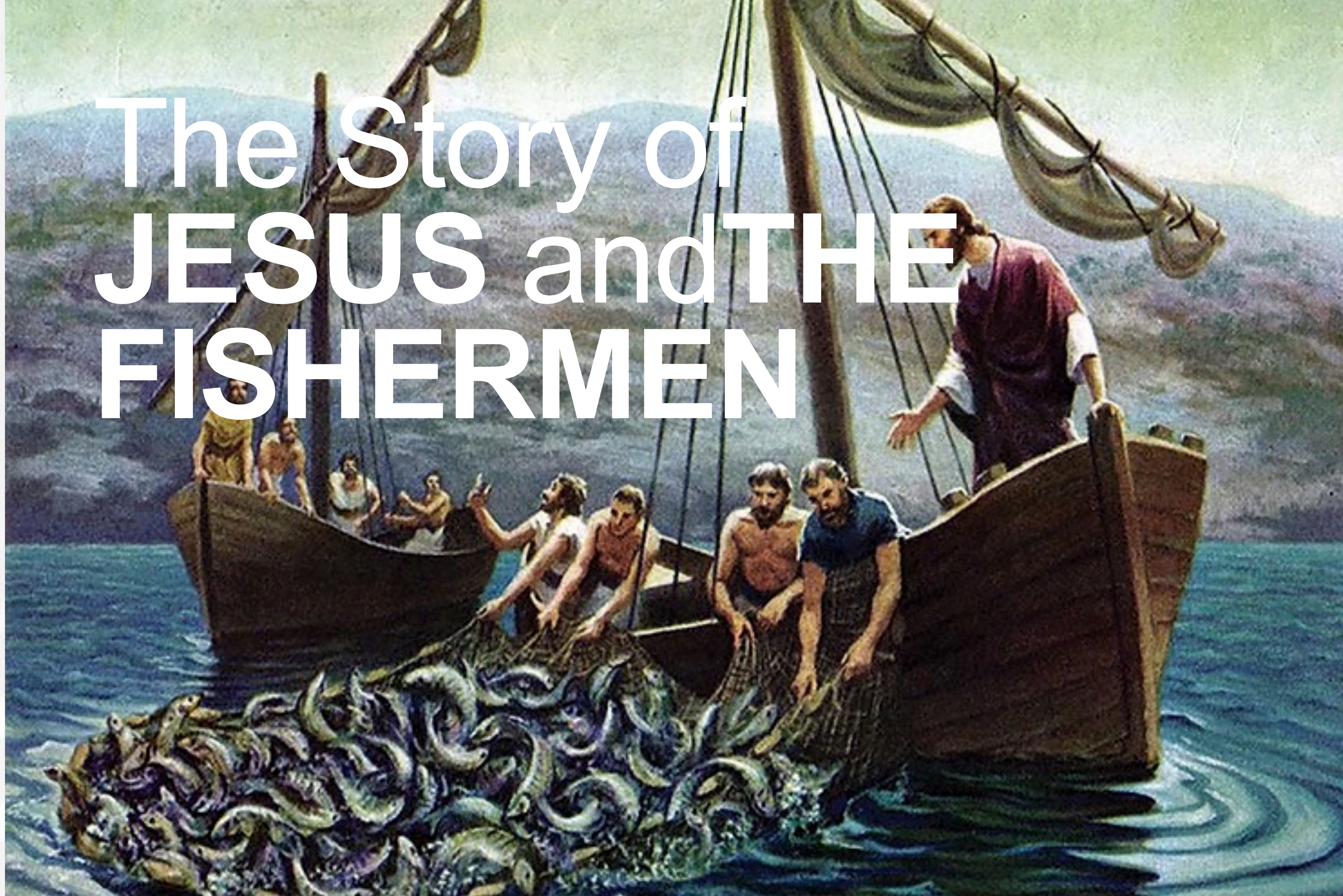

**Luke 5:4-11 NJKV**

*4 When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, "**Launch out** into the deep and let down your **nets** for a catch." 5 But Simon answered and said to Him, "Master, we have **toiled all night** and **caught nothing**; nevertheless **at Your word** I will let down the net." 6 And when they had done this, they **caught** a great number of fish, and **their net** was breaking.*

## Luke 5:7-11 NJKV

7 So they **signaled** to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they **came** and **filled** both the boats, so that they **began to sink**.

8 When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!" 9 For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish which they had taken;

## Luke 5:10-11 NJKV

<sup>10</sup> *and so also were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid. **From now on you will catch men.**"* <sup>11</sup> *So when they had brought their boats to land, they **forsook** all and **followed** Him.*
