

Luke 8:40-42 ESV

40 Now when **Jesus** returned, the crowd welcomed him, for they were all waiting for him. 41 And there came a man named Jairus, who was a ruler of the synagogue. And falling at Jesus' feet, he implored him to come to his house, 42 for he had an only daughter, about twelve years of age, and she was dying.



Luke 8:49-50 ESV

While he was still speaking, someone from the ruler's house came and said, "Your daughter is dead; do not trouble the Teacher any more."

50 But Jesus on hearing this answered him, "Do not fear; only believe, and she will be well."



Luke 8:52-55 ESV

52 And all were weeping and mourning for her, but he said, "Do not weep, for she is not dead but sleeping." 53 And they laughed at him, knowing that she was dead. 54 But taking her by the hand he called, saying, "Child, arise." 55 And her spirit returned, and she got up at once. And he directed that something should be given her to eat.

Luke 7:11-17 ESV

11 Soon afterward he went to a town called Nain, and his disciples and a great crowd went with him. 12 As he drew near to the gate of the town, behold, a man who had died was being carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow, and a considerable crowd from the town was with her. 13 And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her and said to her, "Do not weep."



Luke 7:14-17 ESV

¹⁴ Then he came up and touched the bier, and the bearers stood still. And he said, "Young man, I say to you, arise." "And the dead man sat up and began to speak, and Jesus gave him to his mother. "Fear seized them all, and they glorified God, saying, "A great prophet has arisen among us!" and "God has visited his people!" "And this report about him spread through the whole of Judea and all the surrounding country.

John 11:17-19 ESV

Now when **Jesus** came, he **found** that **Lazarus** had already been **in the tomb four days**.

Bethany was near Jerusalem, about **two miles off**, 19 and many of the Jews had come to Martha and Mary to console them concerning their brother.



John 11:21-27 ESV

"Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died. "But even now I know that whatever you ask from God, God will give you."

"Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again."
"Martha said to him, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection on the last day."



John 11:25-27 ESV

25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, 26 and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die. Do you believe this?" 27 She said to him, "Yes, Lord; I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, who is coming into the world."

1 Kings 18:41-43 ESV

41 Then Elijah said to Ahab, "Go up, eat and drink; for there is the sound of abundance of rain." 42 So Ahab went up to eat and drink. And Elijah went up to the top of Carmel; then he bowed down on the ground, and put his face between his knees, 43 and said to his servant, "Go up now, look toward the sea." So he went up and looked, and said, "There is nothing." And seven times he said, "Go again."



1 Kings 18:44-46 ESV

Then it came to pass the seventh time, that he said, "There is a cloud, as small as a man's hand, rising out of the sea!" So he said, "Go up, say to Ahab, 'Prepare your chariot, and go down before the rain stops you.'"



1 Kings 18:45-46 ESV

- Now it happened in the meantime that **the sky** became black with clouds and wind, and there was a heavy rain. So Ahab rode away and went to Jezreel.
- 46 Then the hand of the Lord came upon Elijah; and **he girded up** his loins and **ran ahead** of Ahab to the entrance of Jezreel.




James 5:16-18 ESV

And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink. 8 When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord!", For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish which they had taken;

and so also were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid. From now on you will catch men." 11 So when they had brought their boats to land, they forsook all and followed Him.
