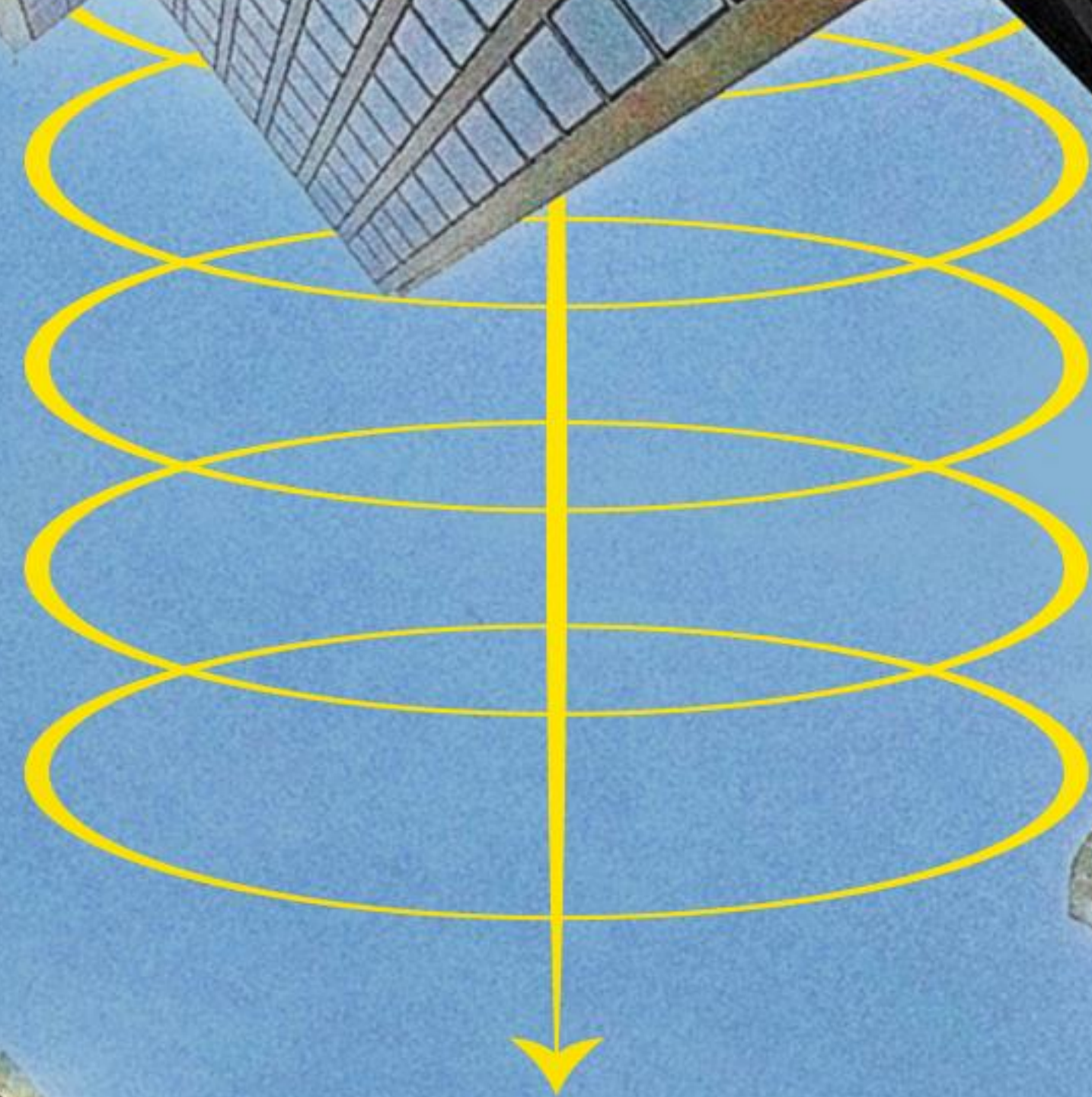

⁶⁶ After this *many of his disciples turned back and no longer walked with him.* ⁶⁷ So Jesus said to the twelve, “*Do you want to go away as well?*”

⁶⁸ Simon Peter answered him, “*Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life,* ⁶⁹ *and we have believed, and have come to know, that you are the Holy One of God.*”

⁴⁸ And he saw that they were making headway painfully, for the wind was against them. And about the fourth watch of the night he *came to them*, walking on the sea. He *meant to pass by them*.

"I AM THE GOOD SHEPHERD"

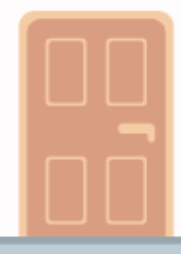


Jesus saves and protects those who believe in Him. (see John 10:11)
