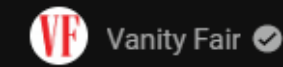

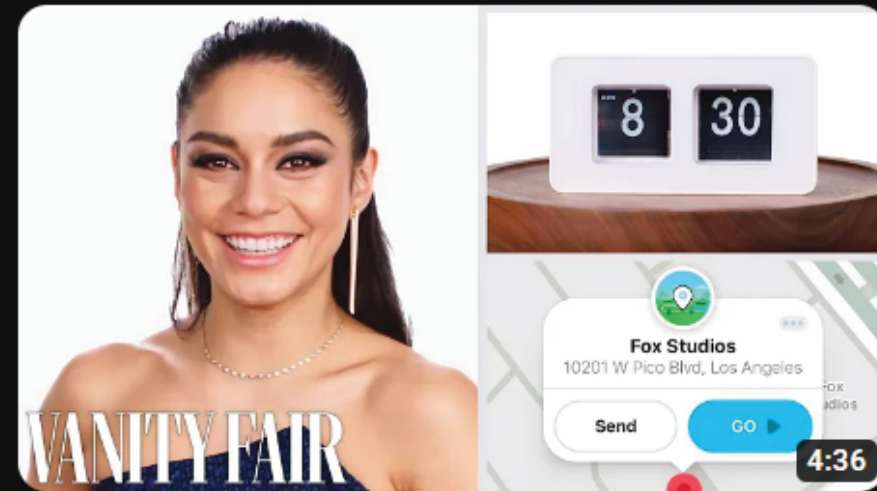

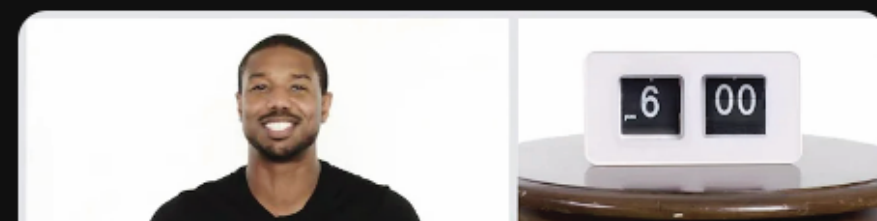

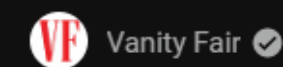

(Based on Mark 1:21-34)

Time of the Day	Event
Morning	Teaching at the synagogue Casting out an unclean spirit
Afternoon	Visiting Simon and Andrew's house Healing Simon's mother-in-law
Evening	Healing service for the whole city
Morning On The Day After (Before Sunrise)	Praying

³⁵ And rising very early in the morning, while it was still **dark**, he departed and went out to a desolate place, and there he prayed. ³⁶ And Simon and those who were with him searched for him, ³⁷ and they found him and said to him, “**Everyone is looking for you.**” ³⁸ And he said to them, “**Let us go on to the next towns, that I may preach there also, for that is why I came out.**”

Jesus' Schedule

(Based on Mark 6:30-52)

Time of the Day	Event
Morning	<p>Inviting the apostles to go to and rest with Him at a desolate place.</p> <p>Followed by the citizens.</p> <p>Jesus had great compassion, so He taught them.</p> <p>It was getting late, and there was no bread.</p> <p>Jesus feeds the 5000+ with 5 loaves and 2 fish.</p>
Evening	Gets everybody to leave (both the disciples and the crowd)
3am to 6am in the morning	Jesus appears to the disciples on the boat

¹⁵ But now even more the report about him went abroad, and great crowds gathered to hear him and to be healed of their infirmities. ¹⁶ But he would withdraw to desolate places and pray.

I can do nothing on my own. As I hear, I judge, and my judgment is just, **because I seek not my own will but the will of him who sent me.**

John 5:30-31

When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do **nothing on my own authority, but speak just as the Father taught me.** And he who sent me is with me. He has not left me alone, **for I always do the things that are pleasing to him.**

John 8:28-29

It is my Father who glorifies me, of whom you say, 'He is our God.' But you have not known him. I know him. If I were to say that I do not know him, I would be a liar like you, but I do know him and I keep his word.

Implications

- Jesus' relationship with the Father is the foundational building block of His ministry and success.
- In Jesus' relationship with the Father, we see that He found rest, direction, wisdom, guidance, and power to carry out His earthly ministry.
- Jesus did not seek out the Father to gain these “benefits”, but the benefits were the result of Him spending time with the Father.
- Jesus sought the Father due to the delight of being in perfect communion with the Father.

Jesus' High Priestly Prayer

I do not ask for these only, but also for those **who will believe in me through their word**, that they may all be one, **just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us**, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. The glory that you have given me I have given to them, **that they may be one even as we are one, I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one**
