


Footsteps of Jesus

Luke 24:33 tells us that he appeared to the "Eleven and those with them.

John 21:14 states: "This is now the third time Jesus showed Himself to His disciples after He was raised from the dead." This seems to contradict the chronological order that I have proposed in this chart. There are four responses to this: 1. My chart is wrong and it is actually the third time Jesus appeared to His disciples. 2. One way to solve the problem is to see

- 1. He comforted the disciples
 - Matthew 28:10 Do not be afraid
 - Luke 24:36 Peace to you
 - John 20:19 Peace be with you... etc.

Jesus focuses on 3 things

- 2. He instructed the disciples
 - Luke 24:27, 44 46 He opened up the scriptures
 - John 20:22 Receive the Holy Spirit

Jesus focuses on 3 things

- 3. He commissioned the disciples
 - Matthew 28:18-20
 - Mark 16:15-18
 - Luke 24:48-49
 - John 20:21
