

High usage of Facebook, Instagram and Snapchat increases the feeling of loneliness.




SOCIAL COMPARISON

FEAR OF MISSING OUT (FOMO)


Social media seems to portray other people having more fun or living better lives than yourself. This perception can impact your self-esteem, trigger anxiety and fuel even greater social media use.


