Holiness Begins With God. God Is Holy.

- Quadosh (Hebrew); Haigos (Greek)
- Separateness / Set apart from everything
- No one like Him
- Morally perfect
- Untouched by sin or evil

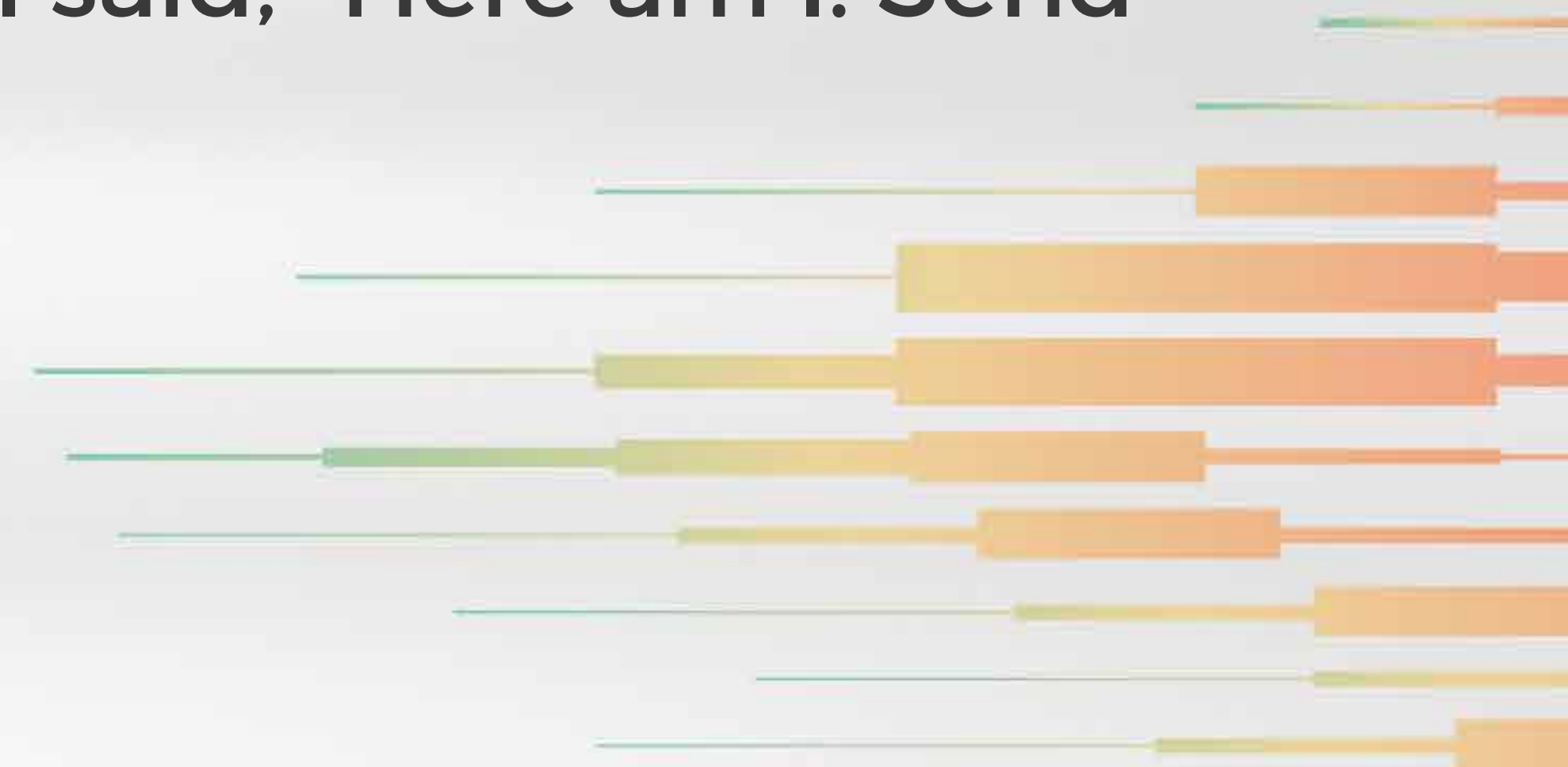
**“Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty;
