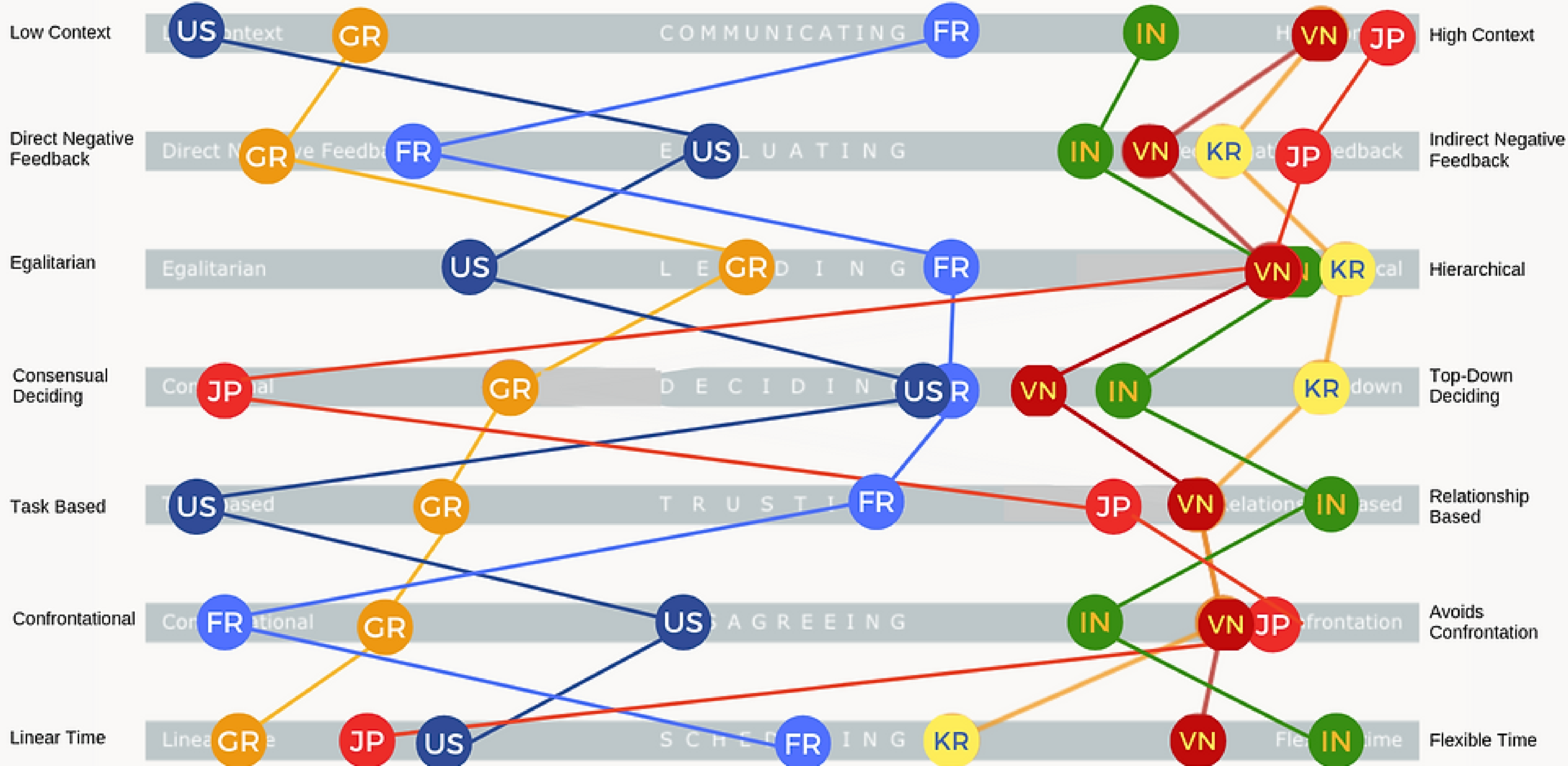


Religious affiliation (2012)
