

# The Call of David

<sup>7</sup> But the Lord said to Samuel... For the Lord sees not as man sees: man looks on the outward appearance, **but the Lord looks on the heart.**"

<sup>10</sup> And Jesse made seven of his sons pass before Samuel... <sup>11</sup> Then Samuel said to Jesse, "Are all your sons here?" And he said, "There remains yet the youngest, but behold, **he is keeping the sheep.**" <sup>12</sup> And he sent and brought him in... And the Lord said, "**Arise, anoint him, for this is he.**"

# The Courage of David

<sup>32</sup> And David said to Saul, "Let no man's heart fail because of him. Your servant will go and fight with this Philistine." <sup>33</sup> "You are not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him, **for you are but a youth**, and he has been a man of war from his youth." <sup>34</sup> But David said to Saul, "Your servant used to keep sheep for his father. And when there came a lion, or a bear, and took a lamb from the flock..."

<sup>36</sup> **Your servant has killed both the lion and the bear...** <sup>37</sup> And David said, "The Lord who delivered me from the paw of the lion and from the paw of the bear will deliver me from the hand of this Philistine." And Saul said to David, "Go, and the Lord be with you!"

# The Posture of David

<sup>6</sup> He said to his men, "The Lord forbid that I should do this thing to my lord, **the Lord's anointed**, to put out my hand against him, seeing he is the Lord's anointed." <sup>7</sup> So David persuaded his men with these words and did not permit them to attack Saul.

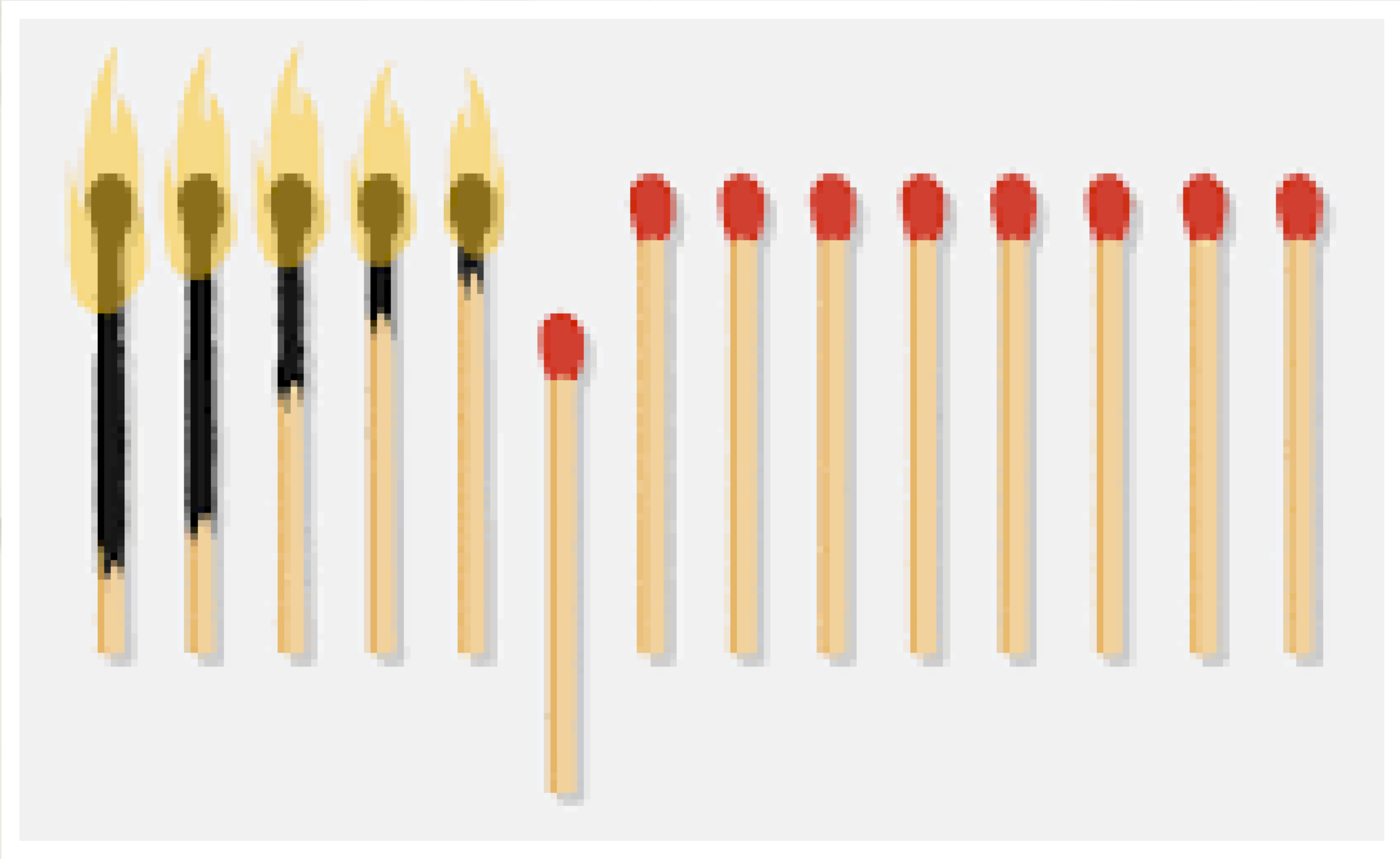
<sup>8</sup> Then David went out of the cave and called out to Saul, "My lord the king!"
