PSALM 19

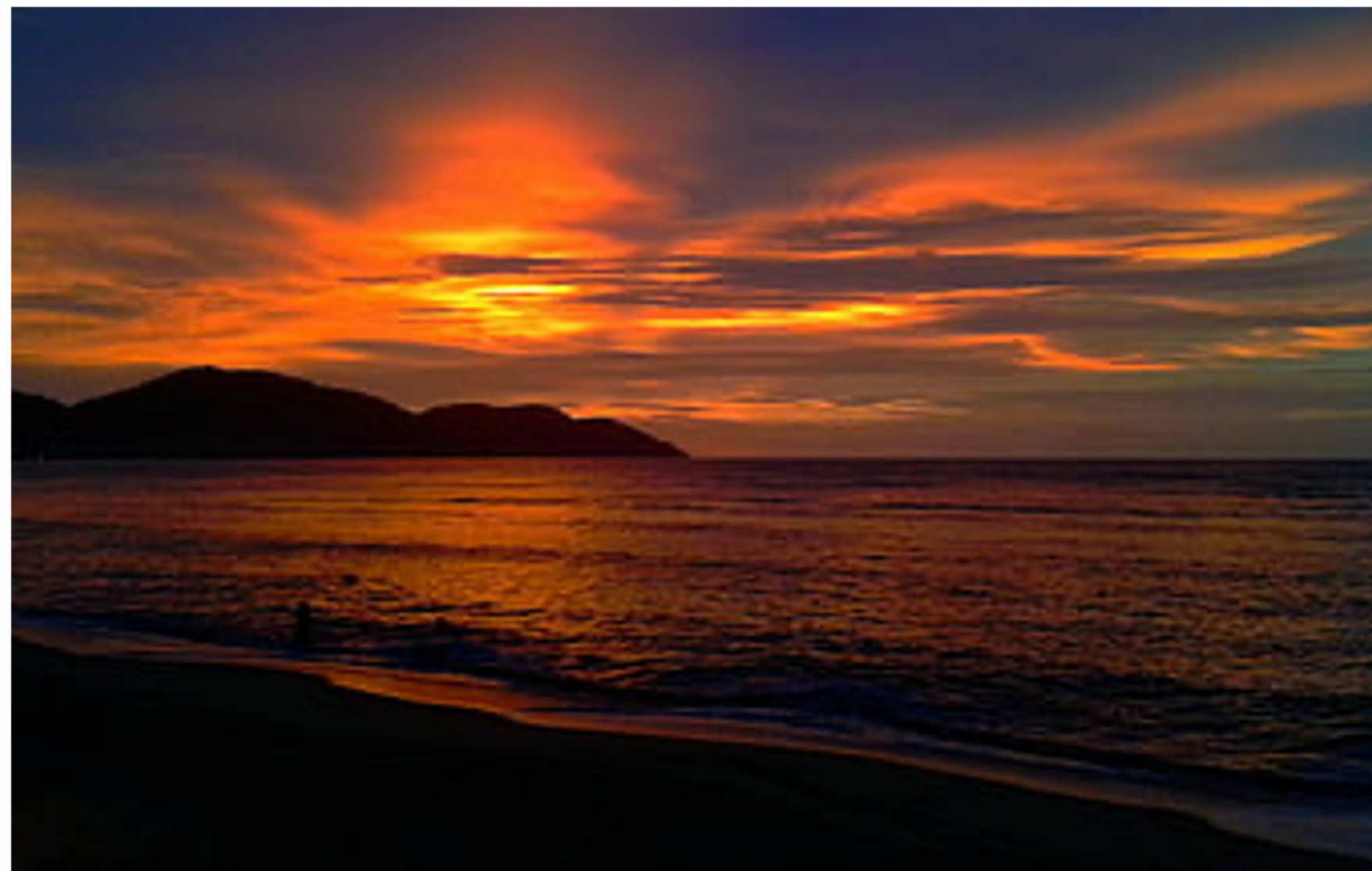
- ¹ The heavens declare the glory of God,
