

PRECARIAT: The

poorest and most deprived class in Britain. With low levels of economic, cultural and social capital, everyday lives of members of this class are precarious.

TRADITIONAL WORKING CLASS: Contains more older

members than other classes but also scores low on all forms of the three capitals. They are not the poorest group.

TECHNICAL MIDDLE CLASS: A less culturally engaged new class with high economic capital.

high economic capital. Small in numbers, they have relatively few social contacts.

NEW AFFLUENT

WORKERS: Generally

have medium levels of

economic capital and

EMERGENT SERVICE WORKERS:

Young and often found in urban areas, this new class has low economic capital but has high levels of 'emerging' cultural capital and high social capital.

ESTABLISHED MIDDLE CLASS: Not quite elite but


CLASS: Not quite elite but members of this class have high levels of all three capitals. They are a gregarious and culturally engaged class.

#3 : ARE YOU ABLE TO BOAST OF YOUR WEAKNESS?

30 If I must boast, I will boast of the things that **show my** weakness. 31 The God and Father of the Lord Jesus, he who is blessed forever, knows that I am not lying. 32 At Damascus, the governor under King Aretas was guarding the city of **Damascus** in order to seize me, 33 but I was let down in a basket through a window in the wall and escaped his hands.

#5 : WILL WE BE CONTENTED TO SAY "WHEN I AM WEAK THEN I AM STRONG?

10 For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

THE QUESTION IS NOT IF WE HAVE WEAKNESS, WE ALL HAVE AND WILL ALWAYS **MIRRORING US; IT IS ABOUT** HOW WE ALLÓW GOD TO **WORK THROUGH US OUR** WEAKNESSES

WEAKNESS IS NOT **SOMETHING WE PURSUE TO BE** STRONG. BUT IT IS WHEN WE ARE WEAK, WE RECOGNISE THAT IT IS GOD WHO MAKES **US STRONG**

AT OUR WEAKEST, GOD'S POWER IS MOST AT WORK WITHIN US. THEN WE ARE AT OUR STRONGEST.





Jesus chose the path of "weakness" and not "strength" to bring salvation to his people.
