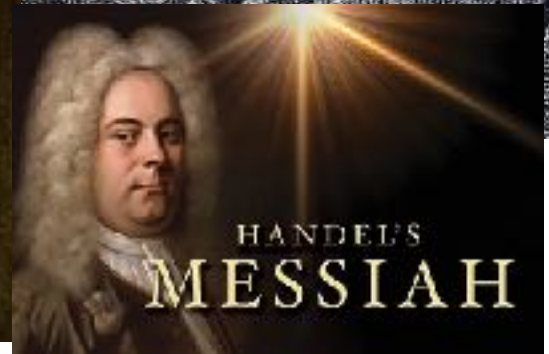
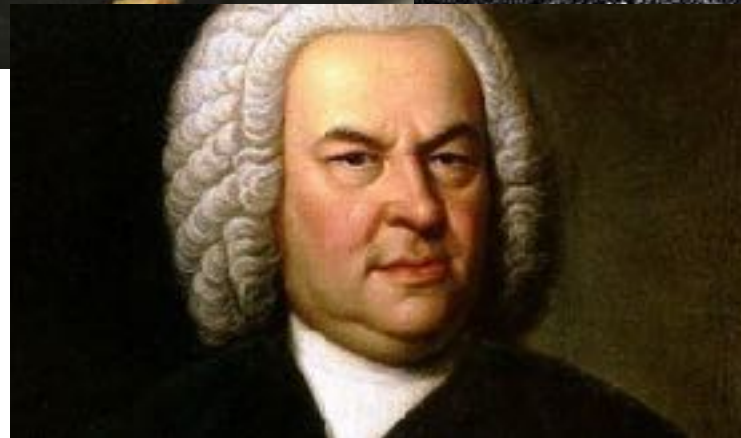

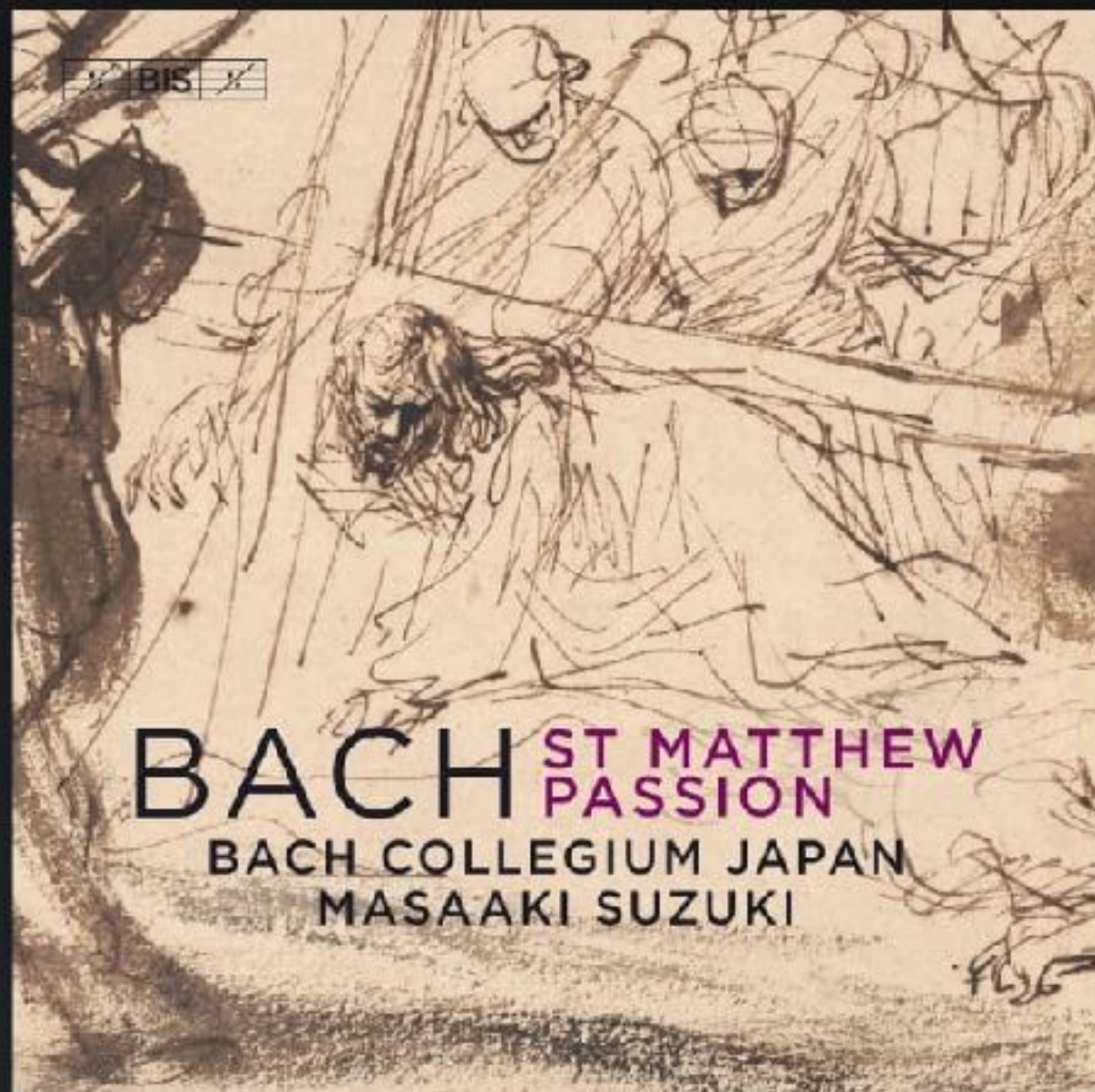

- Psalm 19 has **inspired** various composers and musicians, especially within the context of Christian **liturgy** and sacred **music**: Heinrich Schütz, Johann Sebastian Bach, Beethoven, Handels

REST FOR REVELATION

Big idea:

REST is a **God-given opportunity** to be away from earthly voices and **grow in awareness of God's revelation** of Himself in our world.

1 The **heavens declare** the glory of God, and
the **sky** above **proclaims** his handiwork.
2 **Day** to day **pours** out speech, and **night** to
night **reveals** knowledge. 3 There is no speech,
nor are there words, whose voice is not heard.

Psalm 19:1-3

v.9, 11 Clean, enduring forever	Warning us
v.9, 11 True and righteous	Great reward in obeying them
