# Danger of Self-Sufficiency: What seems like STRENGTH can become a burden when it fosters the belief that we must always be in control, excluding reliance on God.

PSALM 3

1 Lord, how many are my foes! How many rise up against me!

2 Many are saying of me, "God will not deliver him."

Psalm 3:1-2

4 I call out to the Lord, and he answers me from his holy mountain.

# Rest is More Than a Physical Need: It's a Spiritual Act of Trust and Defiance Against the Idol of SelfSufficiency

#### 1. The Temptation of Self-Sufficiency

- Human life is a constant battle between choosing hope in God and hope in other things.
- Self-sufficiency often leads to spiritual isolation. Believing that we can manage without God creates a barrier between us and His provision.



#### 1. The Temptation of Self-Sufficiency

David acknowledges that his protection and honor come not from his own abilities, but from God.

"But you, Lord, are a shield around me, my glory, the One who lifts my head high."

Psalm 3:3





#### 2. Resting Amidst the Storm

One of the most striking aspects of Psalm 3 is David's ability to find rest amidst turmoil.

"I lie down and sleep; I wake again, because the LORD sustains me."

Psalm 3:5



#### 2. Resting Amidst the Storm

- Rest is an act of resistance and faith.
- It reflects a profound faith in God's character.
- God is not passive but actively defending us.



#### 3. The Blessing of Surrender

David's final words in Psalm 3 are a testament to the peace and rest that comes from surrendering to God.

"From the LORD comes deliverance. May your blessing be on your people."

Psalm 3:8



#### 3. The Blessing of Surrender

 When we surrender, we acknowledge God's sovereignty, trusting that His plans and purposes are higher and better than our own.

 Surrender brings peace by releasing the burden of control and anxiety.

"Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

Matthew 11:28-30

The act of resting in God is a powerful declaration of our DEPENDENCE on Him and a powerful act of resistance against the culture of self-sufficiency.
