




# PAUL'S 1ST LETTER TO THE CHURCH IN CORINTH

# SEXUAL IMMORALITY Chapter 5 - 6

<sup>1</sup> It is actually reported that there is **sexual immorality among you**, and of a kind that is not tolerated even among pagans, for a man has his father's wife. <sup>2</sup> And you are **arrogant**! Ought you not rather to mourn? Let him who has done this be removed from among you.

<sup>6</sup> Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump? <sup>7</sup> Cleanse out the old leaven that you may be a new lump, as you really are unleavened.

# SEXUAL IMMORALITY Greek - porneia

"But now I am writing to you **not to associate with anyone** who bears the name of brother if he is guilty of sexual immorality or greed, or is an idolater, reviler, drunkard, or swindler—not even to eat with such a one. <sup>12</sup> For what have I to do with judging outsiders? Is it not those inside the church whom you are to judge? <sup>13</sup> God judges those outside. "Purge the evil person from among you."

## THE PROBLEM

"All things are lawful for me," but not all things are helpful. "All things are lawful for me," but I will not be dominated by anything. "Food is meant for the stomach and the stomach for food"—and God will destroy both one and the other. The body is not meant for sexual immorality, but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body. "And God raised the Lord and will also raise us up by his power.

The body is meant for sexual desires	The body is meant for the Lord

<sup>3</sup> But among you there must **not be even a hint** of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are improper for God's holy people.

EPHESIANS 5:3

<sup>15</sup> **Do you not know** that your bodies are members of Christ? Shall I then take the members of Christ and make them members of a prostitute? Never! <sup>16</sup> **Or do you not know** that he who is joined to a prostitute becomes one body with her? For, as it is written, "The two will become one flesh." <sup>17</sup> But he who is joined to the Lord becomes one spirit with him.

1 CORINTHIANS 6:15-17

<sup>18</sup> Flee from sexual immorality. Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own body. <sup>19</sup> Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, <sup>20</sup> for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

**Flee** also youthful lusts; but **pursue** righteousness, faith, love, peace **with those** who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

Glorify God (v20)
