#1: **IT IS NOT** ABOUT ANTI-WEALTH BUT IS ANTI-WORRY

#1: IT IS NOT ABOUT ANTI-WEALTH BUT IS ANTI-WORRY

#2: **IT IS NOT** ABOUT ANTI-POSSESSION BUT IS ANTI-HOARDING

24 Consider the **ravens**: they **neither** sow nor reap, they have **neither** storehouse nor barn, and yet God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds! Luke 12:24 ESV



20 But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul is required of you, and the things you have prepared, whose will they be?'
21 So is the one who lays up treasure for himself and is not rich toward God.'

Luke 12:20-21 ESV



#3: **IT IS NOT ABOUT** ANTI-PREPARATION BUT IS ANTI-ANXIETY

27 Consider the **lilies**, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin, yet l tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. 28 But if God so clothes the grass, which is alive in the field today, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, how much more will he clothe you, O you of little faith!

#I : IT IS ABOUT SEEKING GOD FIRST

29 And do not seek what you are to **eat** and what you are to **drink**, nor be worried. 30 For all the nations of the world seek after these things, and your Father knows that you need them. 31 Instead, seek his kingdom, and these things will be added to you.

#2: **IT IS ABOUT** TRUSTING GOD'S PROVISION

32 "Fear not, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom. 33 Sell your possessions, and give to the needy. Provide yourselves with moneybags that do not grow old, with a treasure in the heavens that does not fail, where no thief approaches and no moth destroys.

Luke 12:32-33 ESV



#3: **IT IS ABOUT** VALUING WHAT'S ETERNAL

33 Sell your possessions, and give to the needy. **Provide** yourselves with moneybags that **do not grow old**, with a treasure in the heavens that **does not fail**, where **no thief approaches** and **no moth destroys**.

#3: **IT IS ABOUT** VALUING WHAT'S ETERNAL

34 For **where** your <u>treasure</u> is, **there** will your <u>heart</u> be also.

Luke 12:34 ESV



Financial freedom in Christ is not about the size of our wealth, but about where we place our trust. Jesus invites us to live in a way that seeks God first, trusts in His provision, and values what is eternal over what is temporary.
