


Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign. Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name **Immanuel**.





## HEBREW: GIBBOR


Definition: Mighty, strong, warrior, hero

To describe individuals who possess great strength, bravery, or valor. It often refers to warriors or heroes who demonstrate exceptional prowess in battle. The word can also denote someone who is mighty in terms of influence or power, not just physical strength.



## EXAMPLES:


- O Genesis 10:9 He was a mighty hunter
- O Judges 6:12 the LORD is with you, valiant warrior
- O Ruth 2:1 of her husband, a man of great wealth of the family
- O 1 Samuel 9:1 a Benjamite, a mighty man of valor
- O Zephaniah 3:17 in the midst of thee [is] mighty; he will save

### GREEK: DUNATOS

Definition: Powerful, mighty, able, possible

To describe someone or something that possesses power, strength, or ability. It can refer to physical strength, capability, or the potential to accomplish something. In the New Testament, it often describes God's omnipotence, the power of faith, or the capability of individuals empowered by God.




## EXAMPLES:

- O Romans 4:21 God had promised, He was able also
- O Acts 25: 5 he said, let the influential men among
- O Romans 9:22 to make his **power** known, endured
- 2 Timothy 1:12 and I am convinced that He is able to guard
- O Luke 18:27 with people are possible with God.



<sup>9</sup> But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. <sup>10</sup> For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am **strong**.

#### PHYSICAL CHALLENGES

Chronic illness or a physical disability, such as poor eyesight or recurring sickness.

#### PERSECUTIONS AND HARDSHIPS

Imprisonment, beating, life-threatening, exposure to harsh conditions.

#### EMOTIONAL AND RELATIONAL CHALLENGES

False accusations and criticism, betrayals, care for the churches.

#### SPIRITUAL STRUGGLES

Spiritual warfare, battling feelings of inadequacy and despair.
