

### Quick facts: 200

- Among the prophetic books of the Bible, Jeremiah is the longest of the prophetic books (covering 40+ years of history).
- The focal point is the destruction of Jerusalem and the exile to Babylon.
- Among all the other prophetic books, we have a glimpse at the inner life of the prophet.

#### **JEREMIAH 12:1-2 (CSB)**

- You will be righteous, LORD,
  even if I bring a case against you.
  Yet, I wish to contend with you:
  Why does the way of the wicked prosper?
  Why do all the treacherous live at ease?
- <sup>2</sup> You planted them, and they have taken root. They have grown and produced fruit. You are ever on their lips, but far from their conscience.,



#### JEREMIAH 20:7-8 (CSB)

- You deceived me, LORD, and I was deceived.
  You seized me and prevailed.
  I am a laughingstock all the time;
  everyone ridicules me.
- <sup>8</sup> For whenever I speak, I cry out, I proclaim, "Violence and destruction!" so the word of the LORD has become my constant disgrace and derision.

#### JEREMIAH 20:9-10 (CSB)

<sup>9</sup> I say, "I won't mention him or speak any longer in his name." But his message becomes a fire burning in my heart, shut up in my bones. I become tired of holding it in, and I cannot prevail.

<sup>10</sup> For I have heard the gossip of many people, "Terror is on every side!
Report him; let's report him!"
Everyone I trusted watches for my fall.
"Perhaps he will be deceived so that we might prevail against him and take our vengeance on him."

#### JEREMIAH 20:11-13 (CSB)

<sup>11</sup> But the LORD is with me like a violent warrior.

Therefore, my persecutors will stumble and not prevail.

Since they have not succeeded, they will be utterly shamed, an everlasting humiliation that will never be forgotten. <sup>12</sup> LORD of Armies, testing the righteous and seeing the heart and mind, let me see your vengeance on them, for I have presented my case to you.

13 Sing to the LORD!
Praise the LORD,
for he rescues the life of the needy
from evil people.

#### JEREMIAH 20:14-16 (CSB)

<sup>14</sup> May the day I was born be cursed. May the day my mother bore me never be blessed.

<sup>15</sup> May the man be cursed who brought the news to my father, saying, "A male child is born to you," bringing him great joy.

Let that man be like the cities the LORD demolished without compassion.
 Let him hear an outcry in the morning and a war cry at noontime

#### JEREMIAH 20:17-18 (CSB)

<sup>17</sup> because he didn't kill me in the womb so that my mother might have been my grave, her womb eternally pregnant.

<sup>18</sup> Why did I come out of the womb to see only struggle and sorrow, to end my life in shame?


